# COOAU A4300 Home Video Projector User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your COOAU A4300 Home Video Projector. Designed for an immersive viewing experience, this projector supports 1080P resolution and a screen size of up to 200 inches, featuring Hi-Fi speakers for enhanced audio. It is compatible with a wide range of devices including TV sticks, phones, laptops, DVD players, and PS4 consoles.

Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product and retain it for future reference.

## 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To ensure safe operation and prevent damage, observe the following precautions:

- Do not block ventilation openings. Ensure adequate space around the projector for proper airflow.
- Do not look directly into the projector lens when the lamp is on, as the bright light can cause eye damage.
- Do not place the projector on an unstable cart, stand, tripod, bracket, or table. The projector may fall, causing serious injury and damage.
- Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched, particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the projector.
- Unplug this projector during lightning storms or when unused for long periods of time.
- Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel. Servicing is required when the projector has been damaged in any way, such as power-supply cord or plug is damaged, liquid has been spilled or objects have fallen into the projector, the projector has been exposed to rain or moisture, does not operate normally, or has been dropped.

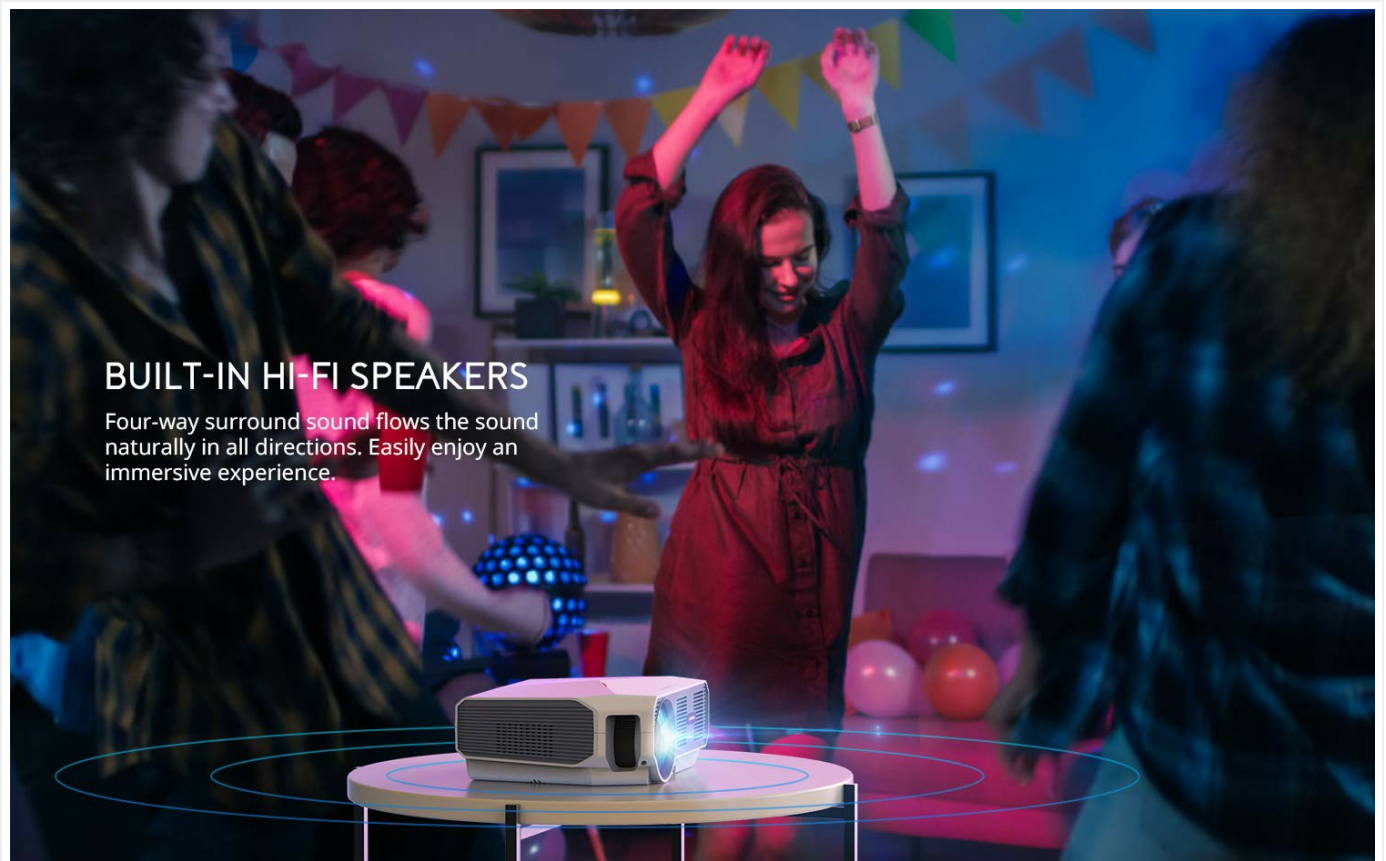
Image: The COOAU A4300 projector shown with its included remote control, illustrating the main unit and a key accessory.

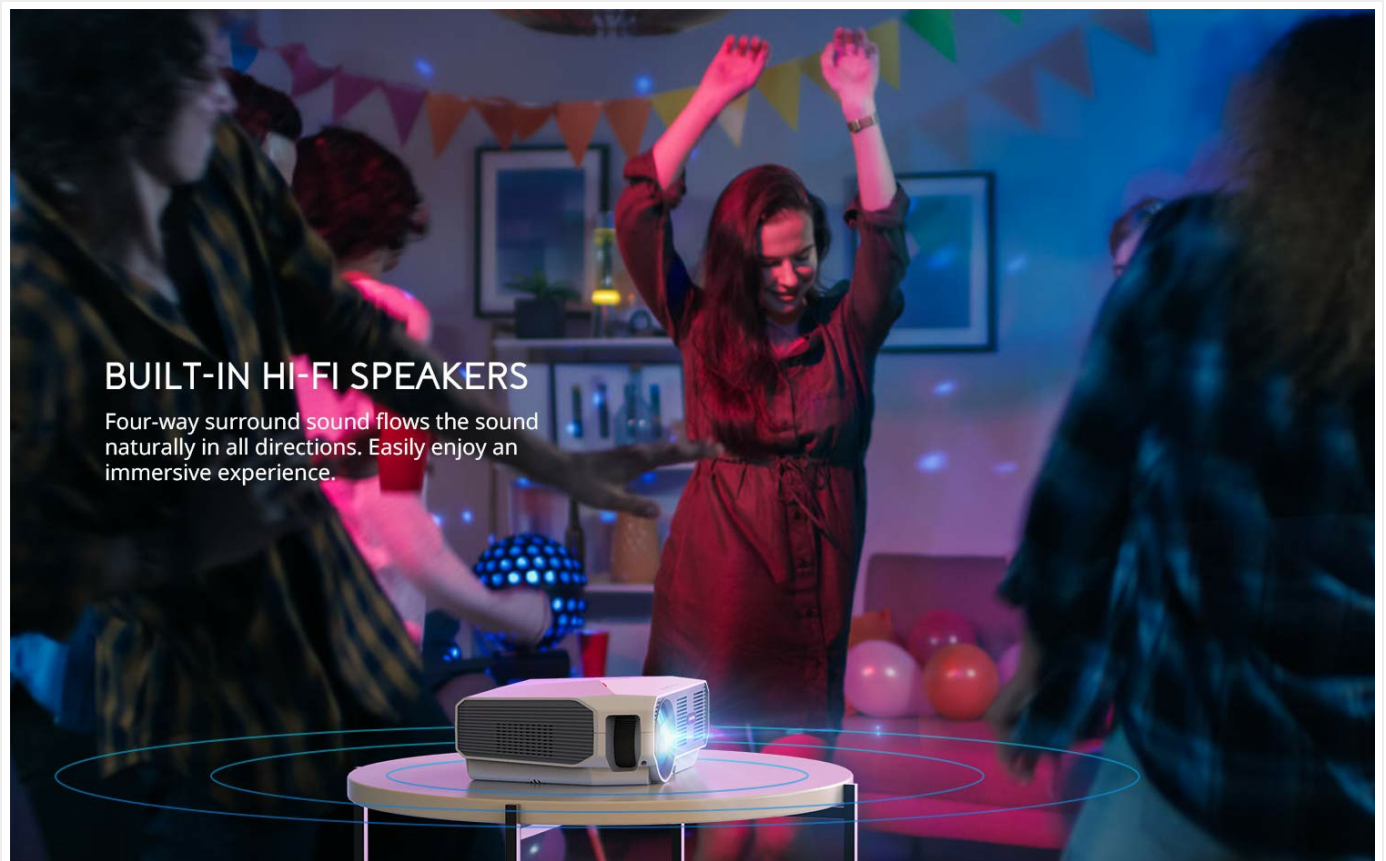

## 4.2. Interface Ports

The COOAU A4300 projector is equipped with a variety of ports to ensure broad compatibility with your devices:

- **AC Input:** For power connection.
- **USB Ports (x2):** For connecting USB drives or other USB devices.
- **VGA Port:** For connecting to computers or laptops.
- **AV Input:** For connecting older devices using the included 3-in-1 AV cable.
- **HDMI Port:** For high-definition audio and video input from various sources.
- **3.5mm Audio Jack:** For connecting external speakers or headphones.

## 5. SETUP GUIDE

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### 5.1. Placement

Place the projector on a stable, flat surface. Ensure there is sufficient space around the projector for ventilation. The optimal projection distance for a 45-200 inch screen is between 4.6ft and 18.7ft.

## 5.2. Power Connection

1. Connect the power cord to the AC input port on the projector.
2. Plug the other end of the power cord into a power outlet.
3. Press the power button on the projector or remote control to turn it on.

## 5.3. Connecting Devices

Connect your desired input device (e.g., TV stick, laptop, game console) to the appropriate port (HDMI, VGA, AV, USB) on the projector.

## 5.4. Focus and Keystone Correction

Adjust the focus ring on the projector lens until the image is clear. Use the keystone correction slider ( $\pm 15^\circ$ ) located behind the projector to correct any trapezoidal distortion of the image, ensuring a perfectly rectangular display.

## 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

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### 6.1. Source Selection

After connecting your device, use the "Source" button on the remote control or projector to select the correct input source (HDMI, VGA, AV, USB).

### 6.2. Image Quality

The COOAU A4300 features 4600 lumens brightness and a 4000:1 contrast ratio, providing a vivid and clear image. It supports a maximum resolution of 1920x1080P with a native resolution of 1280x720P.

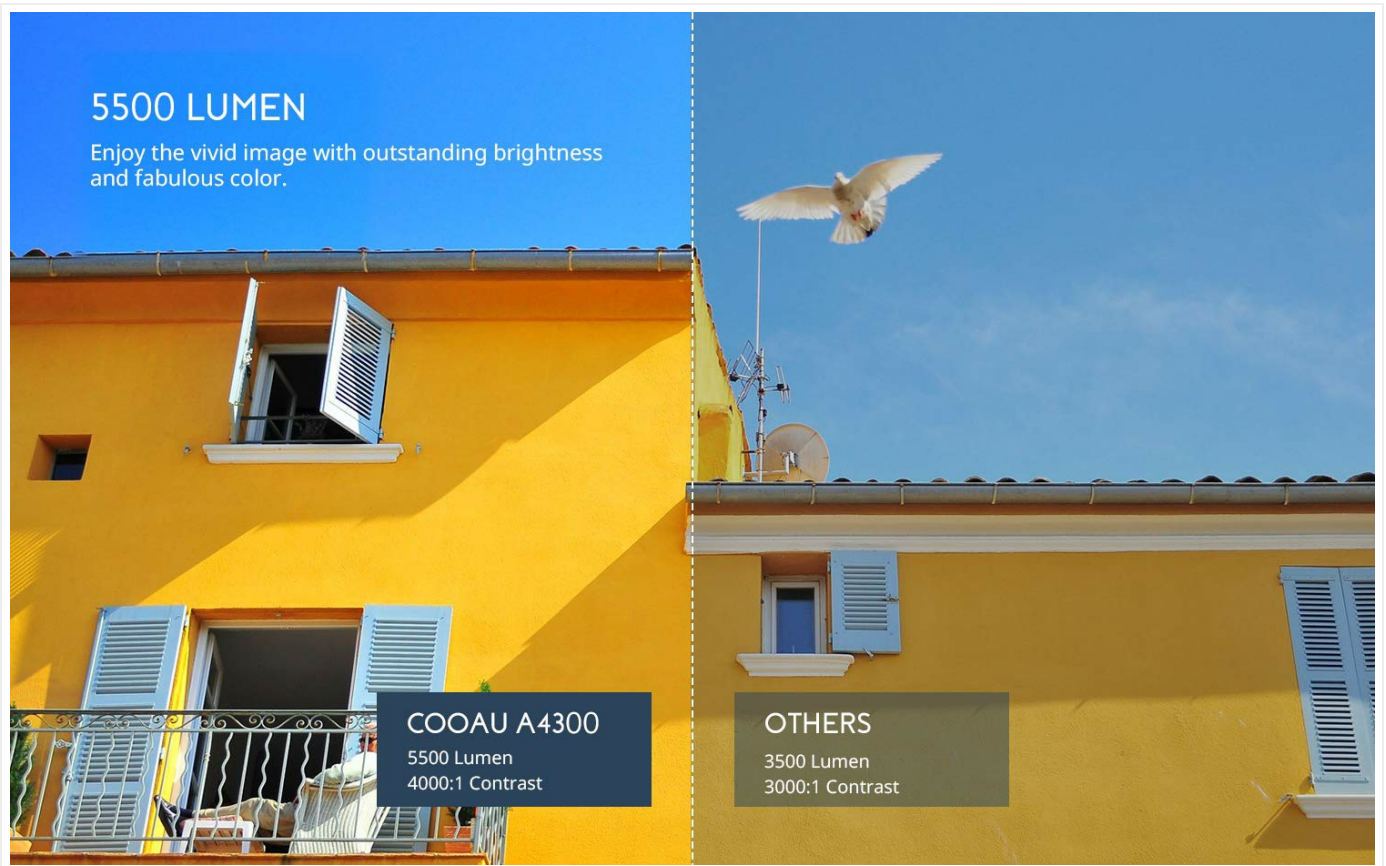

### 6.3. Audio Output

The projector includes built-in Hi-Fi speakers for a powerful and immersive sound experience. You can also connect external speakers or headphones via the 3.5mm audio jack.

## 6.4. Screen Mirroring (Smartphone Connectivity)

The COOAU A4300 supports screen mirroring, allowing you to display content from your smartphone on a larger screen. This requires an external adapter (not included):

- **iOS Devices:** Lightning to HDMI adapter.
- **Android Devices:** Micro USB/Type C to HDMI adapter.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

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### 7.1. Cleaning the Lens

Use the provided cleaning cloth or a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the projector lens. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

### 7.2. Cooling System and Lamp Life

The COOAU A4300 features an advanced cooling system with two fans to ensure efficient heat dissipation and extend the lamp's lifespan. The LED light source is designed for up to 70,000 hours of operation. Regularly ensure that the ventilation vents are clear of dust and obstructions.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your projector, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **No Image:**

- Ensure the power cord is securely connected and the projector is turned on.
- Verify that the correct input source is selected (HDMI, VGA, AV, USB).
- Check the connection cable between the projector and the source device.

- **Blurry Image:**

- Adjust the focus ring on the projector lens.
- Ensure the projection distance is within the recommended range (4.6ft-18.7ft).

- **Image is Trapezoidal:**

- Use the keystone correction slider to adjust the image shape.
- Ensure the projector is placed on a level surface and is perpendicular to the screen.

- **No Sound:**

- Check the volume level on both the projector and the source device.
- Ensure audio cables are properly connected if using external speakers.
- Verify that the audio format is supported (MP3 / M4a).

- **Remote Control Not Working:**

- Check and replace the batteries in the remote control.
- Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote control and the projector's IR receiver.
