OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Empava gas cooktop is designed for precise and efficient cooking.

Burner Ignition and Flame Adjustment

To ignite a burner, push down and turn the corresponding control knob counter-clockwise to the 'High' position. The igniter will spark, lighting the gas. Once lit, release the knob and adjust the flame to your desired intensity. The cooktop features

five versatile burners:

- **Triple Ring Burner:** 13,000 BTU (Ultra-rapid)
- **Large Burner:** 10,200 BTU (Rapid)
- **Medium Burners (x2):** 6,000 BTU (Semi-rapid)
- **Small Burner:** 3,800 BTU (Auxiliary)

Safety Features

The cooktop is equipped with flame failure thermocouple auto shut-off protection technology. This feature automatically cuts off the gas supply if a flame accidentally extinguishes, enhancing safety in your kitchen.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and appearance of your cooktop.

Cleaning the Tempered Glass Surface

The black tempered glass surface is stain and heat discoloration resistant, making cleanup minimal. Use a soft cloth and a mild cleaner specifically designed for glass or ceramic cooktops. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads that could scratch the surface.

Cleaning Grates and Burner Caps

The durable, laser-cut, full-width edge-to-edge heavy cast iron grates are dishwasher safe for effortless cleaning. Remove them along with the burner caps and wash them in your dishwasher or by hand with warm, soapy water. Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your cooktop, refer to the following common solutions before contacting service.

- **Burner Not Lighting or Staying Lit:**

- Ensure the gas supply valve is open.
- Verify that burner caps and rings are correctly seated and aligned.
- Check if the igniter is sparking. If not, ensure the cooktop is properly connected to power.
- If the flame extinguishes shortly after lighting, the thermocouple might not be sensing the flame. Ensure the burner is clean and dry.

- **Flame Too High or Too Low on Minimum Setting:**

- The cooktop has factory-set flame levels. If adjustment is needed, it typically involves a small brass adjustment screw located near the valve stem under the control knob. This adjustment should ideally be performed by a qualified technician to ensure proper gas-air mixture and safety.

- **Control Knobs Become Hot During Use:**

- It is normal for control knobs to become warm during extended cooking, especially when using larger pots on front burners. Use caution when touching them.

- **Gas Connection Issues:**

- If you experience difficulty with gas connections during installation, consult a certified gas technician. Ensure all fittings are appropriate for your local standards (e.g., 1/2" NPT for US).
