1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Medcursor Massage Gun. This handheld percussion deep tissue massager is designed to provide powerful relief for sore muscles and stiffness, promoting relaxation and recovery. Featuring a high-torque brushless motor, it operates quietly and efficiently. This manual provides essential information for safe and effective use of your device.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Important Safety Precautions:

- Do not use the massage gun while charging or plugged in. Always unplug the charger before use.
- Allow the massage gun to cool down after use before charging or storing.
- Keep the charger and massage gun away from water and other liquids.
- Always follow the charging instructions provided with the product to ensure safe charging and prevent potential hazards.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND COMPONENTS

The Medcursor Massage Gun comes with a main unit and six interchangeable massage heads, designed for various muscle groups and massage needs. A convenient carrying case is included for portability and storage.

Massage Heads:

6 Interchangeable Heads

ROUND:

For large muscle groups(quads, glutes, etc.)
or extream soreness

FLAT:

For general use, relaxing for whole body muscles

FORK:

For shoulder, spinal, calves, etc.

CONE:

Apply to strike the deep tissue of the joint,
feet, wrist, etc.



5



METAL:

Smooth and easy to clean ,suitable for
sensitive skin and oil massage

SHOVEL:

For lager muscles around legs and low back

- 1. Round Head:** Ideal for large muscle groups such as quads, glutes, and for extreme soreness.
- 2. Flat Head:** Suitable for general use and relaxing whole body muscles.
- 3. Fork Head:** Designed for targeting the shoulder, spinal area, and calves.
- 4. Cone Head:** Best for striking deep tissue in joints, feet, and wrists.
- 5. Metal Head:** Smooth and easy to clean, suitable for sensitive skin and oil massage.
- 6. Shovel Head:** Recommended for larger muscles around the legs and lower back.

4. SETUP

Charging the Device:

Before first use, fully charge the massage gun. The device is equipped with a high-quality 2000mAh*3 rechargeable Lithium battery. A full charge can provide up to 4.5 hours of use, depending on the speed level and pressure

applied.

- Connect the USB charging cable to the charging port on the massage gun.
- Plug the other end of the cable into a compatible USB power adapter (not included) or a USB port.
- The battery indicator lights will show the charging status. A green light indicates 70%-100% charge, yellow for 30%-70%, and red for 0%-30%.
- Once fully charged, disconnect the charger.

Attaching Massage Heads:

To attach a massage head, simply align the base of the desired head with the opening on the front of the massage gun and push it firmly into place. To remove, pull the head straight out.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Medcursor Massage Gun features a simple one-button operation for ease of use.

Power On/Off:

- To turn the device **ON**, long press the power button.
- To turn the device **OFF**, long press the power button again.

Adjusting Speed Levels:

The massage gun has 5 adjustable speed levels (1200-3200 RPM) to customize your massage intensity.

- Once the device is on, short press the power button to cycle through the 5 speed levels.
- The gear indicator lights will illuminate to show the current speed setting.

Speed Levels and RPM

Speed Level	RPM Range	Recommended Use
1	1200 RPM	Muscle Activation
2-3	1600-2200 RPM	Fascia Relaxation
4	2800 RPM	Deep Massage
5	3200 RPM	Professional Mode

Intelligent Timer and Shutdown:

The device features a 10-minute intelligent timer to prevent overuse and a 60-second intelligent shutdown feature to save battery when in standby mode.

6. USAGE GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION AREAS

Select the appropriate massage head and speed level for the specific muscle group you wish to target. Gently apply the massage gun to the desired area, moving it slowly over the muscle. Avoid direct contact with bones or joints.

Recommended Usage for Each Head:

- **Round Head:** Best for large muscle groups such as pectoralis major, rectus abdominis, gluteus maximus, quadriceps, hamstrings, and gastrocnemius.
- **Flat Head:** Suitable for general relaxation across the entire body's muscles.

- **Fork Head:** Ideal for the neck, shoulder, spinal muscles, and trapezius.
- **Shovel Head:** Recommended for larger muscles around the legs and lower back, including latissimus dorsi and sartorius.

- **Cone Head:** Perfect for precise deep tissue work on areas like the deltoid, biceps brachii, triceps brachii, wrist, and feet.
- **Metal Head:** Can be used on various areas for a smooth massage, including deltoid, biceps brachii, and triceps brachii.

7. MAINTENANCE

Cleaning:

- Before cleaning, ensure the device is turned off and unplugged from any power source.
- Wipe the main unit with a slightly damp cloth. Do not immerse the device in water or any other liquid.
- The massage heads can be cleaned with mild soap and water, then thoroughly dried before reattaching.

Storage:

- Store the massage gun and its accessories in the provided carrying case.
- Keep the device in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Medcursor Massage Gun, please refer to the following common solutions:

Common Issues and Solutions

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not turn on.	Low battery or not charged.	Charge the device fully. Ensure the charging cable is securely connected.
Massage head falls out during use.	Head not securely attached.	Ensure the massage head is pushed firmly into the device until it clicks into place.
Device stops unexpectedly.	Intelligent timer activated (10-minute auto-off) or low battery.	Restart the device if the timer was activated. If battery is low, recharge the device.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unusual noise or vibration.	Foreign object or internal issue.	Turn off the device and inspect for any obstructions. If the issue persists, contact customer support.


