SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: To reduce the risk of injury, adult supervision is required. Never use on roadways, near motor vehicles, on or near steep inclines or steps, swimming pools or other bodies of water; always wear shoes, and never allow more than one rider.

- Always ensure the child is wearing appropriate safety gear, including a helmet, if applicable.
- Do not operate the vehicle in unsafe conditions such as rain, snow, or on slippery surfaces.
- Keep hands, hair, and clothing away from moving parts.
- Regularly inspect the vehicle for any loose parts, damage, or wear before each use.

ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Best Choice Products 12V Kids Ride On Truck Car is required before first use. Please follow the detailed instructions provided in the included Assembly Guide. Ensure all connections are secure and all parts are correctly installed.

Key assembly steps typically include:

1. Attaching the wheels and axles.
2. Connecting the steering column and steering wheel.
3. Installing the seat and connecting the battery.
4. Attaching any additional accessories like mirrors or decorative elements.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Charging the Battery

Before first use, fully charge the vehicle's 12V battery for 8-12 hours. Subsequent charges should be 8-12 hours, but no more than 18 hours. Connect the charger to the charging port, typically located under the seat or on the dashboard, and plug it into a standard wall outlet. The indicator light on the charger will show the charging status.

Manual Operation

For manual driving, the child can use the foot pedal to accelerate and the steering wheel to control direction. The vehicle has forward and reverse gears, usually controlled by a switch on the dashboard.

Parental Remote Control

The included remote control allows parents to safely guide the vehicle. It typically features forward/reverse controls, steering, and a stop button. To pair the remote, refer to the Assembly Guide for specific instructions. Ensure the remote's batteries are fresh for optimal performance.

MAINTENANCE

Battery Care

- Always recharge the battery after each use.
- If the vehicle is not used for an extended period, charge the battery at least once a month to prolong its lifespan.
- Do not overcharge the battery.
- Store the battery in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

Cleaning

Clean the vehicle with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents, as they may damage the plastic parts. Avoid spraying water directly onto electrical components.

General Inspection

Periodically check all screws, nuts, and bolts to ensure they are tight. Inspect the wheels, tires, and steering components for any signs of wear or damage. Lubricate moving parts as needed.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vehicle does not move	Low battery; Loose battery connection; Blown fuse; Motor issue	Charge battery; Check battery terminals; Replace fuse; Contact support
Remote control not working	Remote batteries dead; Remote not paired; Interference	Replace batteries; Re-pair remote (refer to guide); Move away from interference sources
Steering issues (e.g., difficulty turning left)	Steering mechanism obstruction or defect	Inspect steering linkage for obstructions; If persistent, contact customer support as this may indicate a design-related issue.
Audio not working or low volume	Volume too low; Device not connected/paired; Speaker issue	Increase volume; Reconnect/re-pair device; Ensure AUX cable is fully inserted; Contact support if speakers are faulty
Short battery life	Battery not fully charged; Old/worn battery; Overloaded vehicle	Ensure full charge cycle; Consider battery replacement; Do not exceed weight capacity
