## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The LUITON Tactical Radio Holster is designed for secure and convenient carrying of two-way radios, walkie-talkies, and other small electronic devices. Constructed from durable 1000D nylon, it features a MOLLE-compatible system for versatile attachment to various gear, an adjustable elastic cord with Velcro for secure device retention, and a robust design suitable for demanding environments.

## 2. KEY FEATURES

### 4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The LUITON Tactical Radio Holster is designed for easy integration with MOLLE (Modular Lightweight Load-carrying Equipment) systems.

## 4.1 Attaching to MOLLE System

1. Locate the two vertical straps with snap buckles on the back of the holster.
2. Thread these straps through the horizontal webbing of your tactical vest, backpack, or belt.
3. Ensure the straps are woven securely through the webbing, alternating between the holster's straps and your gear's webbing.
4. Fasten the snap buckles at the bottom of the straps to secure the holster firmly in place.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 5.1 Inserting a Radio

1. Ensure the elastic cord on the front of the holster is loosened.
2. Slide your two-way radio or other device into the main compartment of the holster. The open-top design allows for easy insertion.
3. Adjust the elastic cord to fit snugly around the top of your radio.

4. Secure the elastic cord by fastening the detachable Velcro strap over the radio, ensuring it is held firmly in place.

## 5.2 Using the Shoulder Strap (Optional)

The holster can also be used with a shoulder strap for alternative carrying options.

1. Attach the D-rings on the holster to the clips of a compatible shoulder strap.
2. Adjust the shoulder strap length (20.4" - 40.1") for comfortable carrying.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and performance of your LUITON Tactical Radio Holster, follow these

maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Hand wash with mild soap and cold water. Do not use bleach or harsh detergents.
- **Drying:** Air dry completely in a shaded area. Do not tumble dry or expose to direct sunlight for prolonged periods, as this can degrade the nylon material.
- **Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the stitching, elastic cord, Velcro, and snap buckles for any signs of wear or damage. Replace if necessary to maintain secure retention.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

- **Radio does not fit:** Ensure the elastic cord is fully loosened. The holster is designed to accommodate various radio sizes, but extremely large or unusually shaped devices may not fit optimally. Refer to the dimensions in the specifications section.
- **Radio feels loose:** Tighten the elastic cord and ensure the Velcro strap is securely fastened over the radio. The detachable Velcro allows for fine-tuning the tension.
- **Holster is not secure on MOLLE:** Double-check that the MOLLE straps are correctly woven through your gear's webbing and that all snap buckles are firmly closed. Improper weaving can lead to instability.
- **Elastic cord is damaged:** While durable, the elastic cord can wear over time. If it loses its elasticity or breaks, it can be replaced with a similar cord.
