1. Introduction

2. PRODUCT FEATURES

The WAP Extreme Turbo 2800 is engineered with advanced features to provide powerful and convenient cleaning:

- **Powerful Performance:** Equipped with a 1900W induction motor and a maximum pressure of 2450 PSI, it is excellent for removing heavy and deep dirt quickly and efficiently.
- Water Efficiency: Reduces water consumption by up to 80% compared to a common hose, providing effective and sustainable cleaning.
- **Versatile Nozzles:** Includes a turbo nozzle for intense cleaning of difficult dirt and an adjustable nozzle (fan or concentrated), offering versatility for different cleaning tasks.
- **Total Stop System:** Automatic water and power cut-off when the trigger is released helps save energy and extends the motor's lifespan.
- **Durable Construction:** Designed with stainless steel pistons and an induction motor for greater longevity and resistance to continuous use.
- Integrated Detergent Applicator: Built-in detergent applicator with control on the lance for easy

application of cleaning solutions.

• **Mobility and Storage:** Features a handle and wheels for easy transport, and an accessory holder to keep components organized.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to set up your WAP Extreme Turbo 2800 high-pressure washer:

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure all accessories listed in Section 7 are present.
- 2. **Handle Assembly:** Attach the handle to the main unit if it is not pre-assembled. Ensure it clicks securely into place.
- 3. **Accessory Holder:** Utilize the integrated accessory holder to store the high-pressure gun, lances, and other accessories when not in use. This optimizes machine movement and storage.
- 4. **Water Inlet Connection:** Connect a garden hose to the water inlet of the high-pressure washer. Use the quick connect adapter and ensure the water filter is properly installed to prevent debris from entering the pump.
- 5. **High-Pressure Hose Connection:** Connect the high-pressure hose to the outlet on the machine and to the high-pressure gun. Ensure all connections are tight to prevent leaks.
- 6. Power Connection: Plug the electric cable into a suitable grounded power outlet (127V).

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Before operating, ensure all connections are secure and the water supply is turned on.

- 1. **Power On:** Turn on the main power switch located on the unit.
- 2. **Prime the Pump:** Squeeze the trigger on the high-pressure gun until a steady stream of water emerges, indicating that air has been purged from the system.
- 3. **Select Nozzle:** Choose the appropriate nozzle for your cleaning task. The adjustable nozzle allows for a fan spray or a concentrated stream. For heavy-duty cleaning, attach the turbo nozzle.
- 4. **Apply Detergent (Optional):** If using detergent, fill the built-in detergent tank. Adjust the detergent flow control on the lance as needed.
- 5. Begin Cleaning: Aim the nozzle at the surface to be cleaned, maintaining a safe distance. Squeeze the

- trigger to start the high-pressure spray.
- 6. **Total Stop System:** When you release the trigger, the Total Stop System will automatically shut off the motor and water flow, conserving energy and reducing wear.
- 7. **Gun Safety Lock:** Always engage the safety lock on the high-pressure gun when not actively spraying to prevent accidental operation.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your high-pressure washer:

- After Each Use: Disconnect the water supply and power. Squeeze the gun trigger to release any remaining pressure. Drain all water from the pump and hose to prevent freezing in cold weather.
- Clean Nozzles: Regularly check and clean the nozzle openings to remove any blockages that may affect spray pattern or pressure.
- Water Filter: Periodically inspect and clean the water inlet filter to ensure a steady flow of clean water to the pump.
- **Detergent Tank:** Rinse the detergent tank thoroughly after each use with detergent to prevent residue buildup.
- **Storage:** Store the unit in a dry, frost-free area. Utilize the integrated accessory and cable holders for neat storage.
- Stainless Steel Pistons: The unit is equipped with durable stainless steel pistons, requiring minimal internal maintenance.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

This section provides solutions to common problems you might encounter:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not start	No power supply; Power switch off; Thermal overload.	Check power connection; Turn power switch on; Allow unit to cool down.
Low pressure	Insufficient water supply; Clogged nozzle; Air in pump; Leaking connections.	Ensure adequate water flow; Clean nozzle; Prime pump; Tighten connections.
Motor runs continuously	Air in pump; Leaking connections; Bypass valve issue.	Prime pump; Check and tighten all connections; Contact support if issue persists.
Pulsating pressure	Air in pump; Clogged nozzle; Water supply restriction.	Prime pump; Clean nozzle; Check water inlet filter and hose for kinks.


