1. INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides detailed guidance for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your genuine Subaru Rear Compartment Cargo Net (Model F551SAN000). This accessory is designed to help secure items in the rear cargo area of your 2020-2025 Subaru Outback, preventing them from shifting or rolling during vehicle motion.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure the cargo net is securely attached to all designated anchor points before placing items inside.
- Do not overload the cargo net beyond its intended capacity.
- Avoid placing sharp or heavy objects that could damage the net or become projectiles in the event of sudden stops or collisions.
- Always distribute weight evenly within the cargo area.
- Regularly inspect the net for any signs of wear, tear, or damage. Replace if necessary.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning installation:

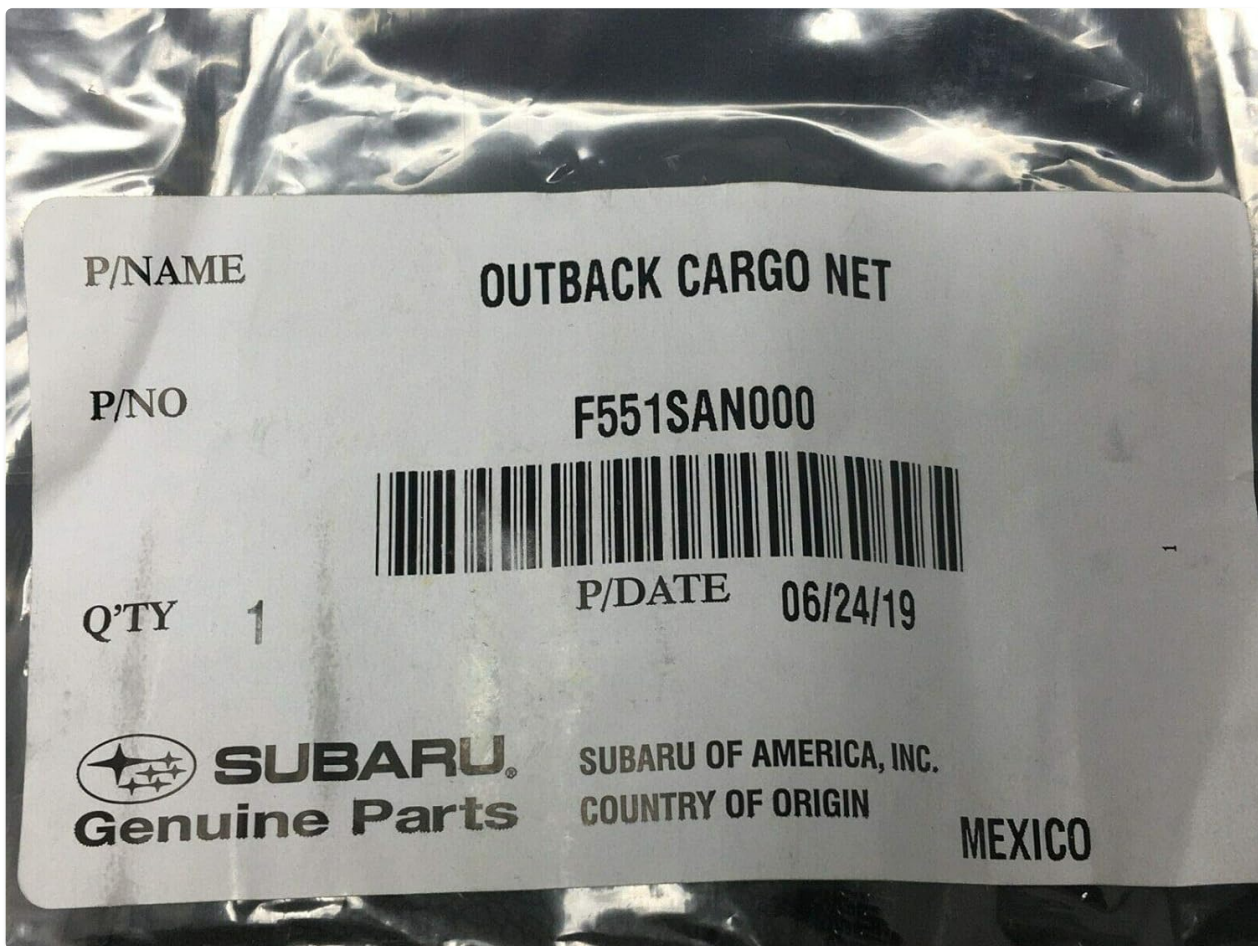


Figure 3.1: Product label for the Subaru Rear Compartment Cargo Net, showing model number F551SAN000.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Subaru Rear Compartment Cargo Net is designed for easy installation using existing anchor points in your vehicle. Some models may require minor preparation if anchor points are not pre-installed.

4.1. Installation Steps

1. Locate the four anchor points in the rear cargo area of your Subaru Outback. These are typically found on the side walls and near the rear hatch opening.
2. Unfold the cargo net and identify the attachment hooks or loops on each corner.
3. Attach the top two hooks of the cargo net to the upper anchor points on the side walls of the cargo area.
4. Attach the bottom two hooks of the cargo net to the lower anchor points, typically located near the floor of the cargo area.
5. Ensure all hooks are securely fastened and the net is taut. The net should stretch across the width of the cargo area.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The cargo net offers versatile options for securing your belongings:

- **Upright Configuration:** Anchor the net to the side of the cargo area to create a barrier that helps prevent items from shifting forward or backward. This is ideal for groceries, bags, or other items you want to keep contained near the tailgate.
- **Flat Configuration:** Lay the net across the floor of the cargo area and secure it to the four anchor points. This method helps keep items from rolling around or sliding under seats.
- **Integrated Storage:** The cargo net may feature a zippered pocket or additional compartments for smaller items, such as reusable shopping bags or emergency tools.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and effectiveness of your cargo net:

- Clean the net periodically with a mild soap and water solution. Rinse thoroughly and allow it to air dry completely before reinstallation or storage.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the material.
- Store the net in a cool, dry place when not in use to prevent mildew or material degradation.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Net not holding items securely:** Ensure all four attachment points are correctly fastened and the net is stretched taut. Avoid placing items that exceed the net's elastic capacity.
- **Difficulty attaching hooks:** Verify that you are using the correct anchor points for your vehicle model. If the hooks are stiff, gently work them to loosen the mechanism.
- **Net appears damaged:** Inspect for frayed edges, broken mesh, or damaged hooks. A damaged net may not securely hold cargo and should be replaced.

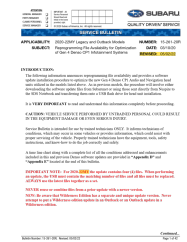
