INTRODUCTION

The Tupperware 450ML Freezer Container is specifically designed for efficient and safe storage of food items in the freezer. Its robust and flexible construction helps prevent breakage in deep freezer conditions. The container features a distinctive snowflake design, indicating its primary utility for frozen storage. This manual provides essential information for the proper use and care of your container.

SETUP

1. Unpacking

Remove the Tupperware Freezer Container from its packaging. Ensure all components, including the container base and lid, are present and undamaged.

2. Initial Cleaning

Before first use, wash the container and lid thoroughly with warm soapy water. Rinse completely and allow to air dry, or dry with a clean cloth. This removes any manufacturing residues.

3. Lid Attachment

Place the lid squarely over the container base. Press down firmly on the center of the lid, then work your way around the edges to ensure a complete and secure seal. A proper seal is crucial for preventing freezer burn and maintaining food freshness.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Filling the Container

Fill the container with your desired food item. Leave a small amount of headspace (approximately 1/2 inch) to allow for expansion during freezing, especially for liquids or foods with high water content.

2. Sealing for Freezer Storage

Ensure the rim of the container is clean and free of food particles before applying the lid. Press the lid firmly onto the container until it snaps into place, creating an airtight seal. This seal is vital for protecting food from freezer burn and preserving its quality.

3. Freezing Guidelines

Place the sealed container in the freezer. The container's flexible material is designed to withstand freezing temperatures without becoming brittle. The snowflake design on the container serves as a visual indicator of its freezer-safe properties.

4. Thawing Guidelines

When ready to use, remove the container from the freezer. Allow frozen contents to thaw in the refrigerator or at room temperature as appropriate for the food type. The container's flexibility aids in easy removal of frozen contents.

5. Material Information

This container is made from high-quality, food-safe virgin plastic, indicated by the 'Code 4' marking, which typically refers to HDPE (High-Density Polyethylene). HDPE is known for its durability, chemical resistance, and suitability for freezer use.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

1. Cleaning

The Tupperware Freezer Container is dishwasher safe. For best results and to prolong the life of the product, place it on the top rack of your dishwasher. Alternatively, hand wash with warm soapy water and a soft sponge or cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads that could scratch the surface.

2. Drying and Storage

Ensure the container and lid are completely dry before storing to prevent odors or mildew. Store with the lid slightly ajar or separated to allow air circulation.

3. Important Considerations

- **Not Microwaveable:** This container is designed for freezer storage only and is **not** suitable for microwave use.
- **Avoid Sharp Objects:** Do not use sharp utensils inside the container, as this may scratch or damage the

plastic.

- **Stain Prevention:** To minimize staining, rinse the container immediately after use, especially after storing foods with strong colors like tomato sauce or turmeric.

Troubleshooting

- **Lid Not Sealing Properly:**
Check if the rim of the container or the lid has any food debris or moisture. Ensure the lid is aligned correctly before pressing down. If the lid appears warped, it may need replacement.
- **Food Odors Persisting:**
Thoroughly wash the container with warm soapy water and a small amount of baking soda to neutralize odors. Ensure the container is completely dry before storage.
- **Container Appears Brittle in Freezer:**
While designed for flexibility, extreme temperature fluctuations or impacts can affect plastic. Ensure the container is not overfilled, especially with liquids, and avoid dropping it when frozen.




