1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Wazor 2-in-1 Flat Iron Professional Ceramic Hair Straightener. This versatile styling tool is designed to help you achieve both sleek straight hair and beautiful curls with ease. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure safe and optimal performance.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: To reduce the risk of burns, electrocution, fire, or injury to persons:

- **Burn hazard:** Surfaces get extremely hot during use. Avoid contact with skin.
- **Electric shock risk:** Keep away from water. Do not use near bathtubs, sinks, or other water sources.
- **Fire risk:** Unplug when not in use. Do not leave unattended when plugged in.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Ensure hair is dry before styling.
- Curl your hair in a well-adjusted position, usually tilted down 45 degrees.
- To avoid scalding, do not touch the hot parts of the flat iron when using.

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

The Wazor 2-in-1 Flat Iron is engineered with advanced technology for superior styling results:

- **2-in-1 Functionality:** Designed to both straighten and curl your hair in one step, allowing for versatile styling.
- **3D Floating Ceramic Plates:** Features 1-inch ceramic coating plates that reduce frizz and make hair smoother and softer. The 3D floating design prevents hair pulling.
- **Instant Heat Up:** Equipped with a PTC heater for consistent temperature throughout use. Heats up to 284°F in approximately 30 seconds.
- **Digital LED Display & Temperature Control:** Adjust temperature from 284°F to 450°F. The LED display allows for precise temperature selection.
- **Memory Function:** A dedicated button to save your favorite heat setting for quick access.
- **Automatic Shut Off:** For safety, the flat iron automatically cuts off power after 60 minutes of inactivity.
- **360° Swivel Cord:** A 1.8m tangle-free swivel cord with attached velcro for convenient use and storage.
- **ETL Certified:** Ensures product safety and quality standards.

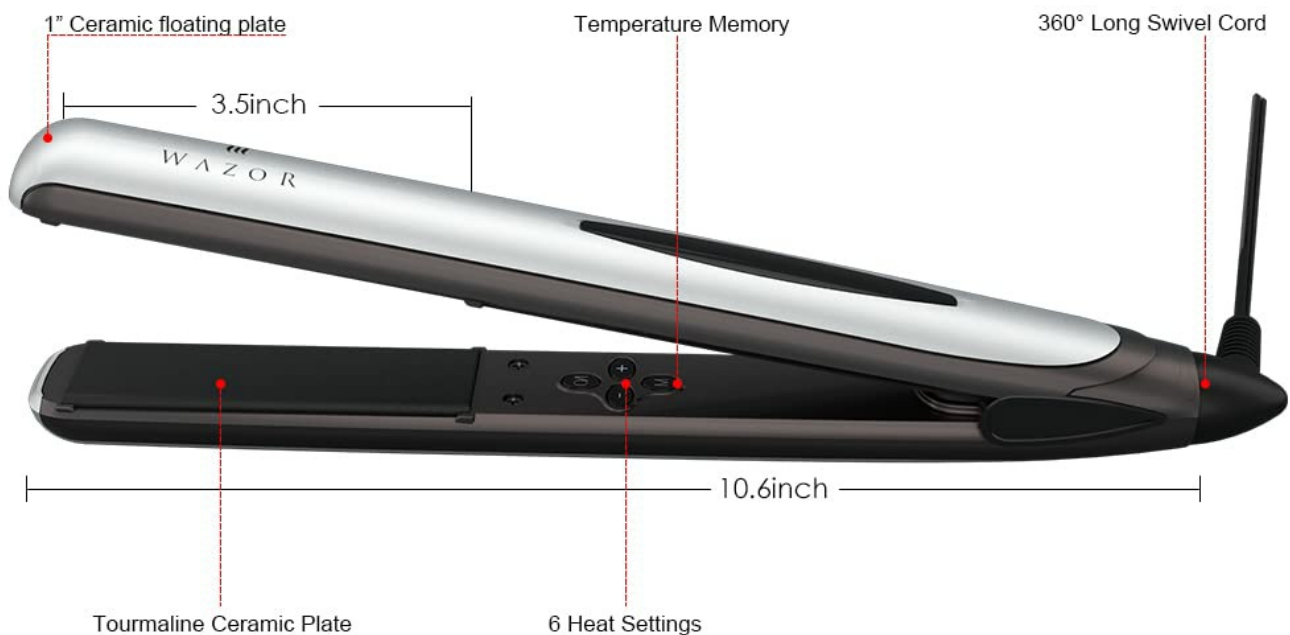


Figure 2: Key features of the Wazor Flat Iron.

4. SETUP

1. **Unpack the Device:** Carefully remove the flat iron and all accessories from its packaging.
2. **Inspect for Damage:** Before first use, inspect the device for any signs of damage. Do not use if damaged.
3. **Plug In:** Insert the power plug into a suitable electrical outlet. Ensure the voltage matches the device's requirements.
4. **Power On:** Press and hold the power button (0/1) until the LED display illuminates.
5. **Select Temperature:** Use the heat adjustment buttons (+/-) to select your desired temperature. The LED display will show the current temperature.
6. **Allow to Heat:** The flat iron will heat up quickly. Wait until the selected temperature is reached and stable before use.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Hair Preparation

1. Ensure your hair is completely dry before using the flat iron.
2. Apply a heat protectant spray evenly throughout your hair to minimize heat damage.
3. Detangle your hair thoroughly with a comb or brush.

5.2 Temperature Selection

Choose the appropriate temperature setting based on your hair type:

- **285-345°F:** For fine, thin, or damaged hair.
- **345-390°F:** For normal or medium hair.
- **390-450°F:** For thick, coarse, or wavy hair.

Use the '+' and '-' buttons to adjust the temperature. The LED display will show the current setting.

5.3 Sectioning Hair

For best results, divide your hair into manageable sections. Start with the bottom layers and work your way up. Use hair clips to secure the upper sections out of the way.

5.4 Straightening Hair

1. Take a small section of hair (about 1-2 inches wide).
2. Place the flat iron near the roots of the section, ensuring not to touch the scalp directly.
3. Gently clamp the plates together and glide the iron slowly and steadily down the hair shaft to the ends. Avoid stopping in one place to prevent kinks or heat damage.
4. Repeat on the same section if necessary, but typically one slow pass is sufficient with ceramic plates.
5. Continue this process for all sections of your hair.

5.5 Curling Hair

1. Take a small section of hair.
2. Open the flat iron and place the hair section between the plates near the roots.
3. Close the plates and rotate the iron 180 degrees away from your face.
4. Slowly glide the iron down the hair shaft, maintaining the rotation. The hair will wrap around the barrel of the iron, creating a curl.
5. Release the hair from the plates and allow the curl to cool before touching it to set the style.
6. Repeat for all sections.

6. MAINTENANCE

1. **Cleaning:** Ensure the flat iron is unplugged and completely cool before cleaning. Wipe the ceramic plates and exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the device in water.
2. **Storage:** Store the flat iron in a cool, dry place. Use the attached velcro strap to keep the 360° swivel cord tidy and prevent tangling.
3. **Cord Care:** Do not wrap the power cord around the appliance as this may damage the cord. Avoid twisting or bending the cord excessively.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Wazor Flat Iron, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **Device not turning on:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet. Check if the outlet itself is functioning.
- **Not heating up:** Verify that the device is powered on and the desired temperature is selected. Allow sufficient time for the iron to reach the set temperature.
- **Hair pulling or snagging:** Ensure hair is thoroughly detangled before use. Take smaller sections of hair. The 3D floating plates are designed to minimize pulling.
- **Automatic shut-off:** The device has a 60-minute automatic shut-off feature for safety. If it turns off during use, simply power it back on.
