INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your Fender Clip-On Tuner Bundle. This bundle includes a versatile FCT-2 multi-function clip-on tuner and a variety of Fender guitar picks, designed to enhance your musical experience. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product.

PRODUCT FEATURES

- Compact, dual-hinged clip-on design for flexible positioning.
- Multi-function tuning modes: Guitar, Bass, Ukulele, Violin, and Chromatic.
- Color LCD screen with an easy-to-read tuning needle.
- Built-in vibration sensor for accurate tuning in noisy environments.
- Picks made from celluloid, offering a warm, round tone.
- Assortment of pick gauges to suit various playing styles.

SETUP

1. Battery Installation (if not pre-installed)

The FCT-2 tuner uses one CR2032 coin cell battery. If the display does not light up, the battery may need to be installed or replaced.

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the tuner.
2. Open the compartment cover.
3. Insert the CR2032 battery with the positive (+) side facing up.
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

2. Mounting the Tuner

The FCT-2 tuner features a clip-on design and dual-hinged articulation for optimal viewing angles.

1. Gently open the clip.
2. Attach the tuner securely to the headstock of your instrument. Ensure the clip has a firm grip without damaging the instrument's finish.
3. Adjust the tuner's display angle using the dual hinges for clear visibility.

OPERATING THE TUNER

1. Power On/Off

Press and hold the power button (usually the main button on the front) for a few seconds to turn the tuner on or off. The display will illuminate when powered on.

2. Selecting Tuning Mode

Briefly press the power button repeatedly to cycle through the available tuning modes: Chromatic (C), Guitar (G), Bass (B), Ukulele (U), and Violin (V). Select the mode appropriate for your instrument.

- **C (Chromatic):** For all instruments, displays the exact note.
- **G (Guitar):** Optimized for standard guitar tuning.
- **B (Bass):** Optimized for standard bass guitar tuning.
- **U (Ukulele):** Optimized for standard ukulele tuning.
- **V (Violin):** Optimized for standard violin tuning.

3. Tuning Your Instrument

1. Ensure the tuner is securely clipped to your instrument's headstock.
2. Pluck a single string on your instrument. The tuner will detect the vibration.
3. Observe the display:
 - The note name will be displayed.
 - The needle on the LCD screen indicates how close you are to the correct pitch.
 - If the needle is to the left and the display is red/orange, the note is flat. Tighten the string.
 - If the needle is to the right and the display is red/orange, the note is sharp. Loosen the string.
 - When the note is in tune, the needle will be centered, and the display will turn green.
4. Repeat for all strings until your instrument is accurately tuned.

USING THE FENDER PICKS

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the tuner with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the tuner and picks in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace the CR2032 battery when the display becomes dim or the tuner stops responding. Dispose of used batteries responsibly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Tuner does not power on.	Dead or improperly installed battery.	Replace the CR2032 battery, ensuring correct polarity.
Tuner is not detecting notes accurately.	Tuner not securely clipped; noisy environment; incorrect mode selected.	Ensure the tuner is firmly clipped to the headstock. Move to a quieter area if possible. Verify the correct tuning mode (G, B, U, V, or C) is selected.
Display is dim or flickering.	Low battery.	Replace the CR2032 battery.
