1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the Magicfly Mini Sewing Machine user manual. This guide provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your new sewing machine. Designed for ease of use, this compact machine is ideal for beginners and various household sewing tasks. The Magicfly Mini Sewing Machine offers dual-speed control, a double thread design for durable stitches, and flexible power options (AC/DC adapter or 4 AA batteries). It comes equipped with an extension table for larger projects and a comprehensive accessory kit to get you started immediately.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your Magicfly Mini Sewing Machine.

- **Take-up Lever:** Guides the upper thread.
- **Tension Screw:** Adjusts upper thread tension.
- **Thread Spindle:** Holds the spool of upper thread.
- **Upper Bobbin:** Spool for the upper thread.
- **Handwheel:** Manually raises and lowers the needle.
- **Winding Pole:** Used for winding thread onto bobbins.
- **Light:** Illuminates the sewing area.

- **ON/OFF Switch:** Powers the machine on or off.
- **Speed Button:** Selects high or slow sewing speed.
- **Presser Foot:** Holds fabric firmly in place while sewing.
- **Presser Foot Lever:** Raises and lowers the presser foot.
- **Thread Cutter:** Conveniently cuts thread after sewing.
- **Lamp:** Provides illumination for the sewing area.
- **Bottom Bobbin:** Holds the lower thread.
- **Foot Pedal Port:** Connects the foot pedal for hands-free operation.
- **DC Power Port:** Connects the AC/DC power adapter.

The practical sewing kit includes 32 bobbins, 5 needles, scissors, a threader, tape measure, seam ripper, and thimble. An extension table is also provided to enhance stability and support larger projects.

3. SETUP

3.1 Power Supply

The machine supports two power options:

- **AC/DC Adapter:** Connect the provided power adapter to the DC Power Port on the machine and plug it into a wall outlet.
- **Battery Power:** For wireless operation, insert 4 AA batteries (not included) into the battery compartment located at the bottom of the machine.

3.2 Extension Table Installation

To use the extension table, align its pegs with the corresponding holes on the machine's base. Ensure the table is placed securely on top of the edge of the machine, not merely even with it, to prevent slipping during use. This provides a larger, more stable working surface for bigger projects.

3.3 Threading the Machine

Proper threading is crucial for smooth operation and to prevent thread breakage or jamming. The machine comes pre-threaded from the factory for testing purposes. It is recommended to follow the threading steps carefully.

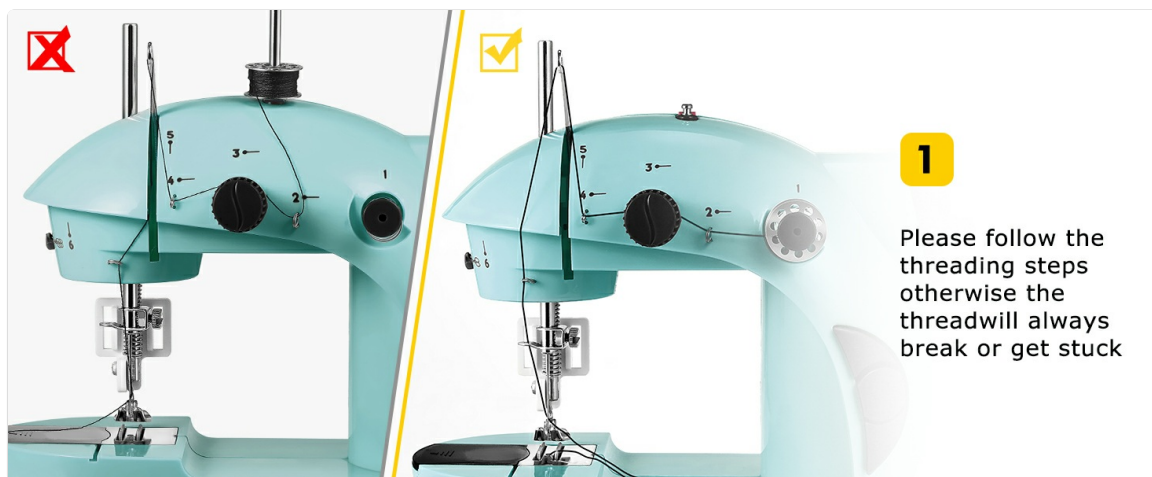


Image 5: Threading Step 1 - Follow the marked threading direction.

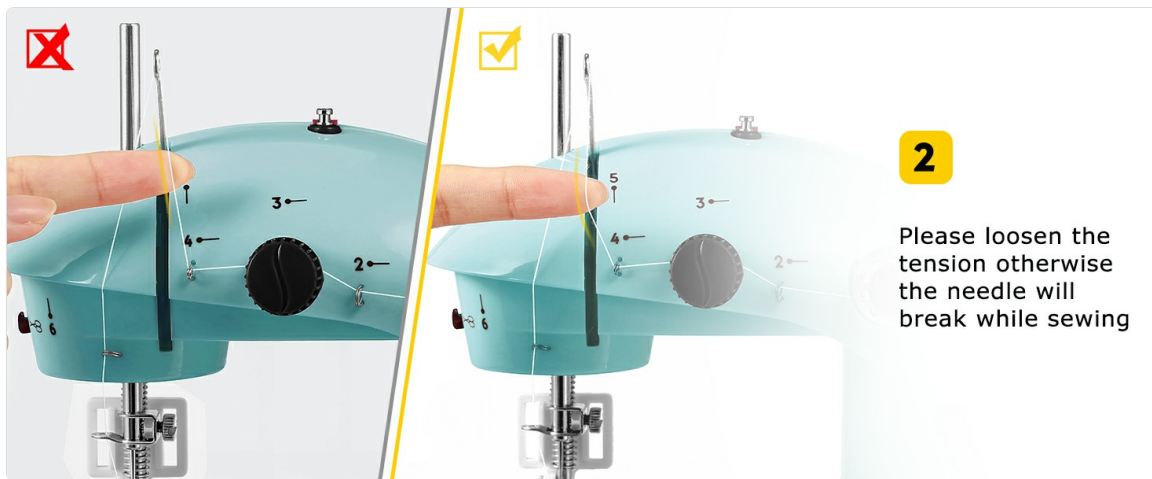


Image 6: Threading Step 2 - Loosen the tension to prevent needle breakage.

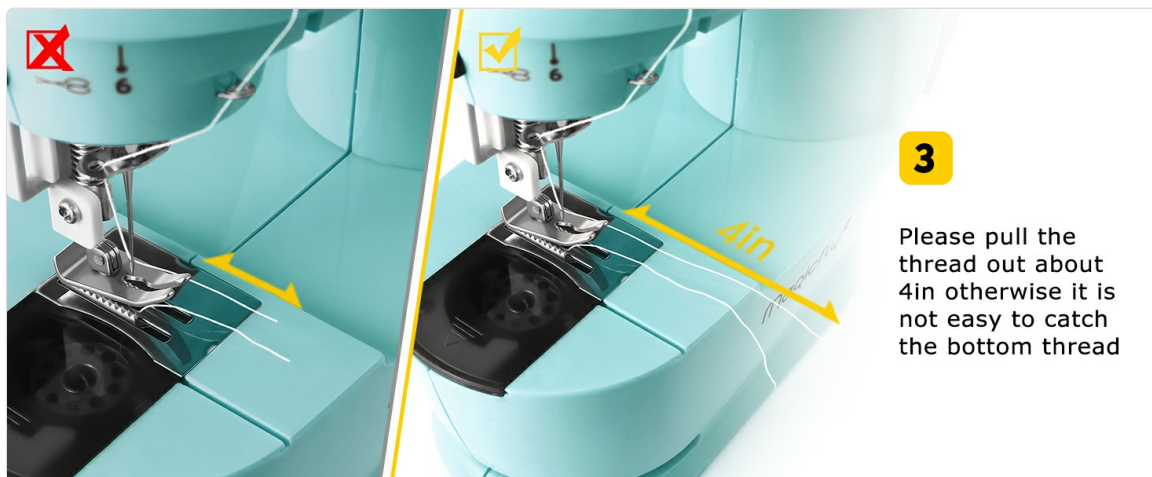


Image 7: Threading Step 3 - Pull out about 4 inches of thread to catch the bottom thread.

3.4 Needle Installation

When installing a new needle, ensure the flat side of the needle faces the throat (right side) of the machine. The top thread should pass through the needle from left to right. The bottom thread will be pulled up through the needle plate by the top thread during initial setup.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Basic Operation

Once the machine is threaded and powered, you can begin sewing. The machine offers two ways to start:

- **Button Operation:** Press the ON/OFF switch on the machine to start and stop sewing.
- **Foot Pedal Operation:** Connect the foot pedal to the Foot Pedal Port. Press the foot pedal to start sewing and release it to stop.

4.2 Speed Adjustment

Use the Speed button to toggle between "high" and "slow" speeds, allowing you to control the pace of

your sewing project.

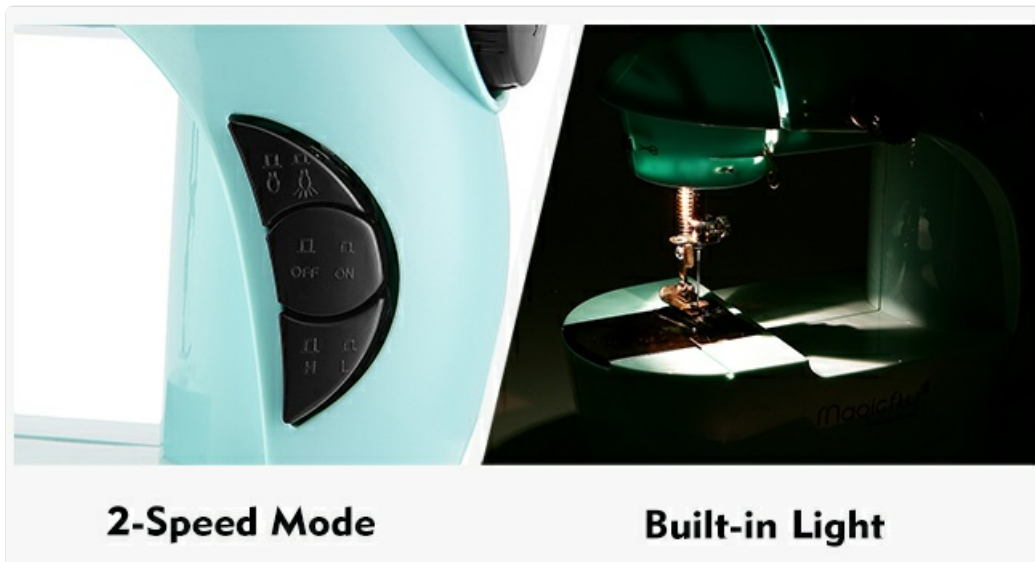


Image 8: Two-speed mode and built-in light feature.

4.3 Straight-Line Sewing

The machine is designed for straight-line stitching with a fixed stitch width and length. It does not have a reverse function.

4.4 Safety Needle Guard

The integrated safety needle guard helps protect your fingers from accidental needle sticks during operation.

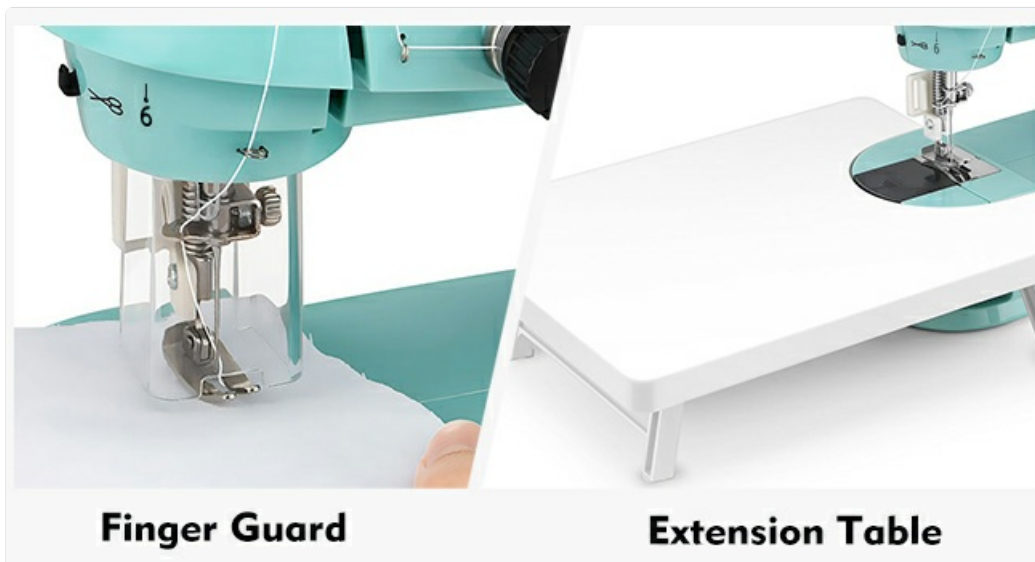


Image 10: Safety finger guard and extension table.

4.5 Winding Bobbins

The machine can be used to wind new thread onto empty bobbins. A winding pole is located on the back of the handwheel. Twist the pole counter-clockwise to extend it, place the empty bobbin on top, and follow the winding instructions in the full manual or online videos. Once done, remove the bobbin and twist the pole clockwise to retract it.

4.6 Applicable Fabrics

The Magicfly Mini Sewing Machine is suitable for a variety of fabrics. Refer to the table below for guidance:

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your sewing machine, regular maintenance is recommended.

- **Cleaning:** Regularly clean lint and dust from the bobbin area and around the needle plate using a small brush.
- **Needle Replacement:** Replace needles frequently, especially when working with different fabric types or if the needle becomes dull or bent.
- **Tension Adjustment:** The machine comes with pre-set tension. Avoid unnecessary adjustments to the tension screw unless you are experienced or following specific troubleshooting steps. Incorrect tension can lead to poor stitch quality.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Magicfly Mini Sewing Machine, refer to the common problems and solutions below.

6.1 Thread Breakage Issues

Thread breakage can occur due to several reasons, including incorrect threading, improper tension, or a damaged needle.

- **Check Threading:** Ensure both upper and lower threads are correctly threaded according to the instructions in Section 3.3.
- **Adjust Tension:** If the thread is too tight, it may break. Slightly loosen the tension screw.
- **Inspect Needle:** A bent or dull needle can cause thread breakage. Replace the needle if necessary.
- **Fabric Compatibility:** Ensure the fabric type and thickness are suitable for the machine (refer to Section 4.6).

6.2 Machine Not Sewing Fabric Together

If the machine is not forming stitches or sewing fabric together, check the following:

- **Bobbin Installation:** Ensure the bottom bobbin is correctly installed and the thread is properly pulled up.
- **Needle Position:** Verify the needle is inserted correctly with the flat side facing the right.
- **Thread Path:** Double-check that the upper thread is correctly routed through all guides and the take-up lever.
