PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This document provides comprehensive instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of the MPC Complete 1-Button Remote Start Kit, designed specifically for Ford F-150 vehicles manufactured between 2009 and 2010 with a gas engine and key-to-start ignition system.

The kit includes a remote starter unit, an immobilizer bypass module, and two 1-button remote controls, offering a range of up to 1500 feet. Firmware is preloaded for your specific vehicle. All components required for installation are included. Installation requires a Windows PC with a USB port for initial setup.

Compatibility and Requirements

- Vehicle Compatibility: Ford F-150, model years 2009-2010.
- Engine Type: Gas engine only. Not compatible with hybrid vehicles.
- Ignition Type: Key-to-Start ignition only. Not compatible with push-to-start vehicles.
- Transmission: Automatic Transmission ONLY.
- Setup Requirement: A Windows PC with a USB port is required to complete the initial setup of the data module.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Installation of this remote start kit requires basic knowledge of automotive electronics wiring. While the included data module simplifies many connections, it is not a plug-and-play system. Concise directions with wire colors and locations are provided to assist with the installation process.

Components Included

- · Remote Start Module
- Immobilizer Bypass Module (Data Module)
- (2) 1-Button Remote Controls

• All necessary wiring harnesses and connectors




Figure 4: The data module and its associated wiring harness, which simplifies the installation by reducing the number of required wiring connections.

Installation Difficulty

While designed to simplify the process, installation requires a basic understanding of car electronics. It is recommended that individuals with limited experience in automotive wiring seek professional assistance or thoroughly review the provided installation tip sheet.




Figure 5: An illustration indicating that the installation of this kit falls into the 'More Difficult' category, emphasizing the need for basic wiring knowledge.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Remote Start Function

To start your vehicle remotely, press the single button on the remote control. The vehicle's engine will start and run for a pre-programmed duration. The remote has an effective range of up to 1500 feet, depending on environmental conditions and obstructions.

Programmable Options

- Run Time Options: The engine run time can be programmed for 5, 10, 20, or 30 minutes.
- Auto-Start Options: The system supports programmable 2, 3, or 4 hourly auto-start options, useful for maintaining engine temperature in extreme weather.
- **Unlock Feature:** An optional feature allows the vehicle to unlock once the engine is running. This is particularly useful if the OEM remote becomes inactive while the vehicle is running.

MAINTENANCE

The MPC Remote Start Kit is designed for minimal maintenance. Regular checks should include:

- Remote Battery Replacement: Replace the remote control batteries as needed to ensure optimal range and functionality. Refer to the remote's specific instructions for battery type and replacement procedure.
- Wiring Integrity: Periodically inspect all installed wiring connections to ensure they remain secure and free from corrosion or damage.
- **Software Updates:** While firmware is preloaded, check the MPC website or contact technical support for any available software updates for the data module that may enhance performance or address compatibility issues.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your MPC Remote Start Kit, consider the following troubleshooting steps:

• Remote Not Responding:

- Check the remote control battery.
- Ensure you are within the specified operating range (1500 ft line of sight). Obstructions like buildings or other vehicles can reduce range.
- Verify that the vehicle's hood is closed and all doors are securely latched.

· Vehicle Does Not Start Remotely:

- Confirm the vehicle is in Park (P) and the parking brake is engaged (if applicable to your vehicle's setup).
- Check for any active warning lights on the dashboard that might prevent remote start (e.g., check engine light, low fuel).
- Ensure all wiring connections are secure and correctly installed according to the provided tip sheet.

• PC Connection Issues for Setup:

- Ensure your Windows PC has a functional USB port.
- Verify that the necessary drivers for the data module are installed.
- Try a different USB cable or port.
