# Westinghouse 50-inch Smart TV WD50FM2009 User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION AND SAFETY INFORMATION

---

Thank you for choosing the Westinghouse 50-inch Smart TV, model WD50FM2009. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your television. Please read these instructions thoroughly before use and retain them for future reference.

### Important Safety Instructions:

- Read all instructions before operating the TV.
- Keep the TV away from water and moisture.
- Ensure proper ventilation; do not block ventilation openings.
- Use only attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- Unplug the TV during lightning storms or when unused for long periods.
- Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

## 2. SETUP

---

### 2.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove the TV from its packaging. Ensure all accessories are present: remote control, power cord, and stand components. Inspect the TV for any damage incurred during transit.

### 2.2 Stand Installation

If you intend to place the TV on a table or cabinet, attach the included stand. Place the TV face down on a soft, flat surface to prevent screen damage. Align the stand bases with the screw holes on the bottom of the TV and secure them with the provided screws.

## **2.3 Connecting Devices**

Your Westinghouse Smart TV offers various connectivity options. Refer to the image below for port locations and descriptions.

- **HDMI (High-Definition Multimedia Interface):** Connect Blu-ray players, game consoles, or set-top boxes. Your TV has two HDMI ports, one of which supports Audio Return Channel (ARC).
- **VGA:** Connect a computer for use as a monitor.
- **USB:** Connect USB storage devices to play media files.
- **LAN (Ethernet):** Connect to your home network for Smart TV features.
- **Optical Audio:** Connect to an external sound system for digital audio output.
- **RF (Antenna/Cable):** Connect an antenna or cable TV signal.

## 2.4 Power Connection

Connect the power cord to the TV's power input and then plug the other end into a standard electrical outlet. The TV will enter standby mode.

## 2.5 Initial Power On

Press the power button on the remote control or on the TV itself. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup, including language selection, network connection, and channel scanning.

## 3. OPERATING

---

### 3.1 Remote Control

The included remote control requires alkaline batteries (included). Insert them according to the polarity markings inside the battery compartment. The remote allows you to control power, volume, channels, input sources, and navigate the Smart TV interface.

### 3.2 Smart TV Features

Your Westinghouse Smart TV provides access to various internet services. Connect the TV to your home Wi-Fi network or via an Ethernet cable (LAN port) to access online content. Popular applications like YouTube and Netflix are typically pre-installed or available for download.

### 3.3 Input Selection

To switch between connected devices (e.g., HDMI 1, HDMI 2, VGA), press the 'Input' or 'Source' button on your remote control and select the desired input from the on-screen menu.

### 3.4 Picture and Sound Settings

Access the TV's menu to adjust picture settings (brightness, contrast, color, sharpness) and sound settings (bass, treble, balance, sound modes) to your preference.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

---

### 4.1 Cleaning the TV

- **Screen:** Gently wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, use a screen-specific cleaning solution applied to the cloth, not directly to the screen.
- **Cabinet:** Wipe the TV cabinet with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.

### 4.2 Software Updates

Periodically check for software updates through the TV's settings menu to ensure optimal performance and access to the latest features. Follow the on-screen prompts for any available updates.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your TV, refer to the following common problems and solutions before contacting support.

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the TV and the electrical outlet. Try plugging another device into the same outlet to confirm it is working.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Verify that the correct input source is selected. Check all cable connections (HDMI, VGA, RF) are secure.
- **Remote Control Not Working:** Check the remote control batteries and replace them if necessary. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor.
- **Network Connection Issues:** Restart your router and modem. Check the TV's network settings to ensure it is connected to the correct Wi-Fi network or that the Ethernet cable is properly connected.
- **Picture Quality Issues:** Adjust picture settings (brightness, contrast, color) in the TV menu. Ensure the input source is providing a high-quality signal.
