INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Mount-It! MI-1860 Floor TV Stand. This stand is designed to support televisions ranging from 32 to 55 inches, with VESA patterns up to 400x400mm, and features tempered glass shelves for media devices. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly to ensure safe and correct installation.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to read and follow all instructions can result in personal injury or damage to property. If you have any questions, please contact customer support.

- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 88 pounds (40 kg) for the TV mount.

- Ensure the VESA mounting pattern of your TV is compatible with the stand (Min: 100x100mm, Max: 400x400mm).
- Always use two people to lift and position the television during installation.
- Place the stand on a level and stable surface.
- Keep children and pets away from the assembly area.
- Do not overtighten screws, as this may cause damage.
- Periodically check all connections to ensure they remain secure.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please verify that all components are present and undamaged before assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer support.

Typical package contents include:

- Base plate (tempered glass)
- Middle shelf (tempered glass)
- Support columns (metal)
- TV mounting bracket assembly
- Various screws, washers, and spacers for assembly and TV attachment
- Cable management clips/ties
- Assembly tools (e.g., Allen wrench)

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps carefully for proper assembly. It is recommended to have a second person assist with TV mounting.

1. **Assemble the Base:** Attach the support columns to the base tempered glass plate using the provided screws and tools. Ensure all connections are secure.
2. **Install Middle Shelf:** Secure the middle tempered glass shelf to the designated support columns.
3. **Attach TV Mount Column:** Connect the main TV mount column to the base assembly.
4. **Prepare TV for Mounting:**
 - Identify the VESA mounting holes on the back of your television.
 - Select the appropriate screws, washers, and spacers from the hardware kit that fit your TV's mounting holes.
 - Attach the vertical TV brackets to the back of your television. Ensure they are level and securely fastened.
5. **Mount the TV:** With assistance, carefully lift the television and hook the attached TV brackets onto the main TV mount column. Ensure the brackets are properly seated.
6. **Secure the TV:** Use the safety screws or locking mechanisms provided to prevent the TV from accidentally lifting off the mount.
7. **Adjust Height:** The TV brackets allow for height adjustment. Loosen the securing bolts, adjust the TV to the desired height, and re-tighten the bolts. Refer to the 'Operating' section for more details.
8. **Cable Management:** Utilize the integrated cable management system within the main column and the provided cable ties to route and conceal TV and media device cables for a clean appearance.


Your Mount-It! MI-1860 TV stand offers flexibility for optimal viewing.

TV Swivel Function

The TV mount allows for a 30-degree swivel to the left and right. Gently grasp the sides of your television and rotate it to achieve your desired viewing angle. Avoid forcing the TV beyond its intended swivel range.

Height Adjustment

The TV mounting brackets can be adjusted vertically to achieve a comfortable viewing height. To adjust:

1. With assistance, carefully support the television.
2. Loosen the securing bolts on the vertical TV brackets that attach to the main column.
3. Slide the TV up or down to the desired position.
4. Ensure the TV is level, then securely re-tighten all securing bolts.




Image: A diagram illustrating the height adjustment mechanism of the TV mount, showing how the brackets can be raised or lowered in 2.4-inch increments.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life and appearance of your TV stand.

- **Cleaning Glass Surfaces:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth and a non-abrasive glass cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the tempered glass finish.
- **Cleaning Metal Surfaces:** Wipe metal parts with a soft, damp cloth. For stubborn marks, a mild soap solution can be used, followed by drying thoroughly.
- **Check Connections:** Periodically (e.g., every 6 months) inspect all screws and bolts to ensure they remain tight and secure. Re-tighten if necessary.
- **Avoid Overloading:** Do not place items heavier than the specified weight capacity on the shelves or mount.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV stand, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Stand is wobbly or unstable.	Loose connections; uneven floor.	Ensure all screws are tightened. Move stand to a level surface or use shims if necessary.
TV is not level.	Brackets unevenly installed; stand not level.	Re-check TV bracket installation. Ensure stand is on a level surface.
Cannot attach TV to mount.	Incorrect VESA pattern; wrong screws/spacers.	Verify your TV's VESA pattern matches the stand's compatibility. Use the correct hardware for your TV model.
Missing parts during assembly.	Packaging error.	Do not proceed with assembly. Contact Mount-It! customer support immediately for replacement parts.





Image: A detailed diagram showing the minimum and maximum dimensions of the MI-1860 TV stand, including height, width, and depth measurements.




