1. Introduction

- It is recommended to have a second person assist during installation to safely position and secure the nerf bars.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The APS iArmor Nerf Bars serve as a convenient and secure step for entering and exiting your truck. Their robust design ensures stability and safety during use.

- **Stepping On:** Place your foot firmly on the slotted step pad. The 6.5-inch width provides ample surface area for secure footing.
- Weight Capacity: The nerf bars are engineered to support up to 500 lbs. Do not exceed this weight limit.
- Safety: Always maintain three points of contact (two hands and one foot, or one hand and two feet) when entering or exiting your vehicle.




Figure 4: Demonstrating the comfortable step-on feeling and 500 lbs weight capacity.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your APS iArmor Nerf Bars, regular maintenance is recommended.

- **Cleaning:** The matte black powder-coated finish is designed for easy cleaning. Use mild soap and water with a soft cloth or sponge. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all mounting hardware for tightness. Re-tighten any loose bolts to ensure the nerf bars remain securely attached to your vehicle.
- Corrosion Resistance: The stainless steel construction and powder coating provide excellent resistance to rust and corrosion. However, regular cleaning, especially after exposure to road salt or harsh environmental conditions, will help maintain their condition.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your APS iArmor Nerf Bars.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Nerf bars feel loose or unstable.	Mounting hardware is not sufficiently tightened.	Inspect all mounting bolts and brackets. Re-tighten them according to the torque specifications in the installation manual.
Unusual noises (rattling, squeaking) from the nerf bars.	Loose hardware or contact with other vehicle components.	Check all mounting points for tightness. Ensure no part of the nerf bar is rubbing against the vehicle's frame or body.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Surface finish appears dull or discolored.	Accumulation of dirt, grime, or exposure to harsh chemicals.	Clean the nerf bars thoroughly with mild soap and water. Avoid using abrasive cleaning tools or strong chemical solvents.
