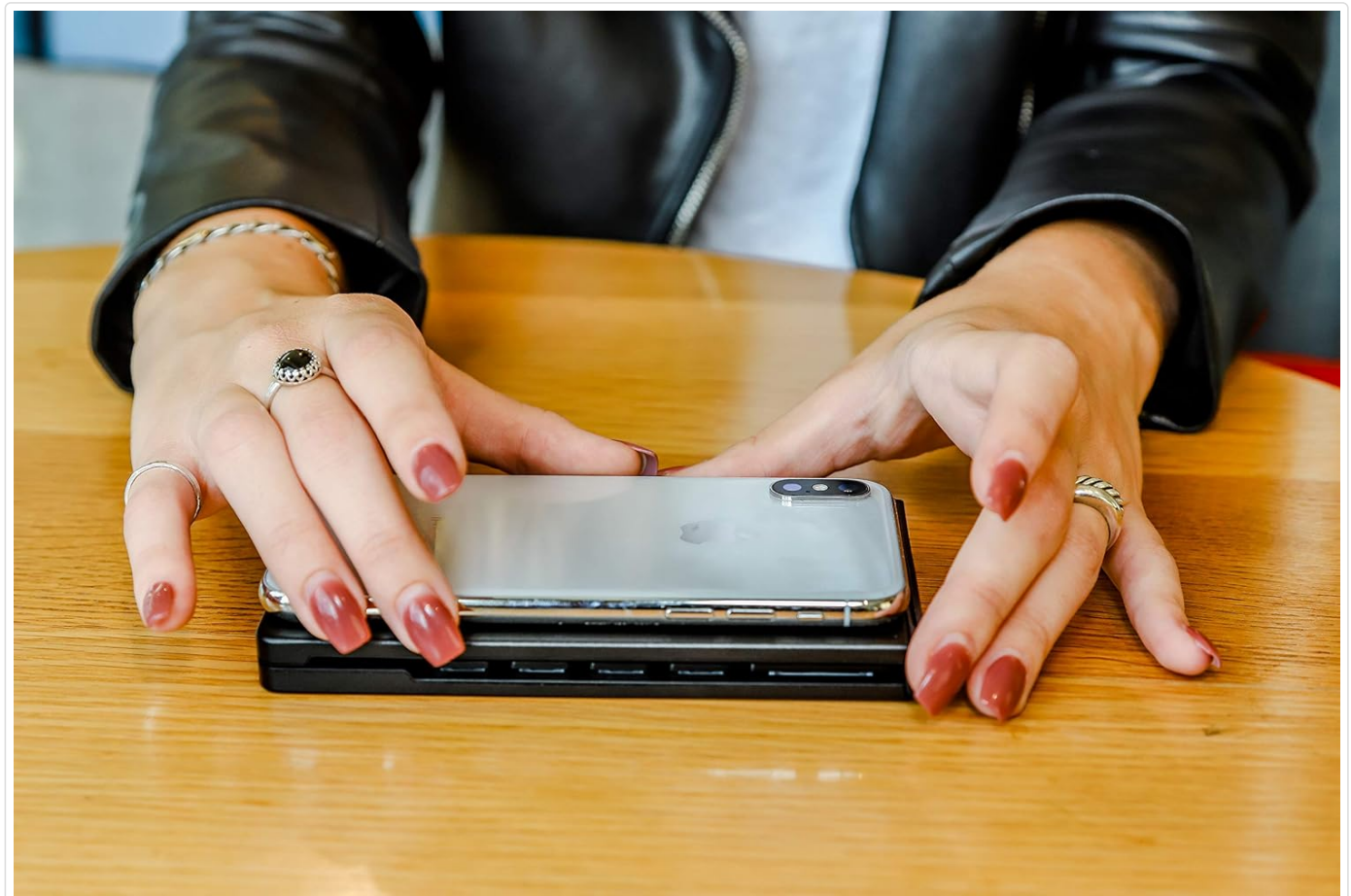

SETUP

Charging the Keyboard

Before initial use, fully charge the keyboard. Connect the provided Micro USB charging cable to the keyboard's charging port and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., computer, wall adapter). The STATUS indicator light will show charging status. A full charge provides up to 60 days of standby time or 2-3 weeks of continuous use.

Pairing with a Device

1. **Power On:** Slide the ON/OFF switch to the 'ON' position. The STATUS indicator will light up briefly.
2. **Enter Pairing Mode:** Press the **CONNECT** button. The STATUS indicator will begin to blink, indicating the keyboard is in pairing mode.
3. **Enable Bluetooth:** On your smartphone, tablet, or computer, go to your device's Bluetooth settings and ensure Bluetooth is enabled.
4. **Select Keyboard:** In the list of available Bluetooth devices, select "TYPE Keyboard".
5. **Confirm Pairing:** Your device may prompt you to enter a code on the keyboard. Follow the on-screen instructions. Once paired, the STATUS indicator will stop blinking.

Switching Operating Systems

The keyboard supports multiple operating systems. To optimize key functions for your device, press the following key combinations:

- **Fn + Q:** For iOS devices (Apple)
- **Fn + W:** For Android devices
- **Fn + E:** For Windows devices

OPERATING THE KEYBOARD

Once paired, the Fashionit TYPE Wireless Keyboard functions like a standard QWERTY keyboard. You can use it for typing, navigating, and executing commands on your connected device.

Function Keys (Fn)

Many keys have secondary functions accessible by holding down the **Fn** key and pressing the desired function key. These typically include media controls, volume adjustments, and other system shortcuts, which may vary slightly depending on your operating system.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

To clean the keyboard, use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or excessive moisture, as these can damage the keyboard.

Storage

When not in use, fold the keyboard to protect the keys. Store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid placing heavy objects on the keyboard.

Battery Care

To prolong battery life, avoid completely draining the battery frequently. Charge the keyboard regularly, even if it's not in constant use. If storing for an extended period, ensure the battery has a partial charge (around 50%).

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Keyboard not turning on:** Ensure the ON/OFF switch is in the 'ON' position. Check the battery level and charge the keyboard if necessary.
- **Keyboard not connecting/pairing:**
 - Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device.
 - Make sure the keyboard is in pairing mode (STATUS indicator blinking). Press the **CONNECT** button if it's not.
 - Move the keyboard closer to your device.
 - Try unpairing and re-pairing the keyboard from your device's Bluetooth settings.
 - Restart both the keyboard and your device.
- **Keys not responding or typing incorrect characters:**
 - Check the battery level.
 - Ensure the correct operating system mode is selected (Fn+Q for iOS, Fn+W for Android, Fn+E for Windows).
 - Verify the keyboard is still connected via Bluetooth.
