INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your Best Choice Products 12V Kids Ride-On Electric ATV, Model SKY5608. Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and operation to ensure your child's safety and the product's longevity.

Key Features:

- **Rugged Design:** Equipped with realistic features for imaginative play.
- **Large, Treaded Wheels:** 4-wheel suspension designed for various terrains including grass, dirt, driveways, and sidewalks. Features LED headlights and a horn.
- **Bluetooth Connectivity:** Allows wireless connection to media devices for audio playback.
- **Realistic Functionality:** Includes a foot pedal accelerator, forward/reverse function, and two speed selections (high & low) with a maximum speed of 3.7 mph.
- **Rechargeable Battery:** Long-lasting 12V battery providing approximately 1.5 hours of run time per charge.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always use common sense and safe practices when operating this vehicle.

- Adult supervision is required at all times.
- Ensure the child wears appropriate safety gear, including a helmet, knee pads, and elbow pads.
- Do not operate the ATV near streets, motor vehicles, steep inclines or declines, swimming pools, or other bodies of water.
- Operate only on flat, dry surfaces. Avoid loose dirt, mud, sand, or gravel.

- Do not allow more than one rider at a time.
- Keep hands, hair, and clothing away from moving parts.
- The maximum weight capacity for this ATV is 66 lbs.
- Recommended age for use is 36 months to 6 years.

SETUP

1. Assembly

Your ATV comes with an assembly guide. Please refer to the included guide for detailed, step-by-step instructions on how to assemble your ride-on vehicle. Ensure all parts are securely fastened before proceeding to charging.

2. Initial Battery Charging

Before first use, the 12V battery must be fully charged. Remove the battery from the ATV and connect it to the included charger. Allow for an initial charge of 8-12 hours. Do not overcharge the battery for more than 18 hours. A full charge provides approximately 1.5 hours of run time.

Rechargeable Battery

Rechargeable 12V battery provides 1.5 hours of run time per charge so kids can have endless enjoyment!

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Power On/Off

Locate the red power button on the dashboard. Press it to turn the ATV on or off. You will hear a startup sound when powered on.

2. Driving Controls

- **Foot Pedal Accelerator:** Press the foot pedal located on the right side to accelerate. Release to slow down or stop.
- **Forward/Reverse:** Use the switch on the dashboard to select between forward and reverse gears.
- **Speed Selection:** A switch on the dashboard allows you to choose between high and low speeds. Start with low speed for younger children or new riders.
- **Steering:** Use the handlebars to steer the ATV left or right.

3. LED Headlights and Horn

The ATV is equipped with functional LED headlights for enhanced visibility and a horn for added fun. These features are typically activated when the ATV is powered on.

4. Bluetooth Audio

To play music, activate the Bluetooth function on the ATV (refer to the dashboard controls for the Bluetooth button). Pair your compatible media device with the ATV. Once connected, you can stream audio through the ATV's speakers.

MAINTENANCE

1. Battery Care

- Always recharge the battery after each use.
- If the ATV is not used for an extended period, charge the battery at least once a month to maintain its lifespan.
- Do not store the battery in extreme temperatures.
- Only use the charger provided by Best Choice Products.

2. General Cleaning

Wipe down the ATV with a damp cloth after use. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Do not spray water directly onto electrical components.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
ATV does not move or has low power.	Battery is low or not charged.	Recharge the battery for the recommended time (8-12 hours). Ensure charger is properly connected.
On/Off switch is unresponsive.	Faulty switch or loose wiring.	Check for loose connections. If the switch is damaged, contact customer support for replacement parts.
Bluetooth audio not connecting.	Device not in pairing mode or too far away.	Ensure the ATV's Bluetooth is active and your device is in pairing mode and within range.
Short run time after full charge.	Battery degradation or improper charging.	Ensure proper charging cycles. If the issue persists, the battery may need replacement. Contact customer support.

Image: Visual representation of the ATV's dimensions.






