#### INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your Parkside PHSSA 20-Li A1 / PAP 20 A1 lithium-ion battery. Please read these instructions carefully before first use and keep them for future reference. This battery is designed for use with compatible Parkside handheld vacuum cleaners, specifically the PHSSA 20-Li A1 (IAN 317699).

#### IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always observe basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and personal injury.

- **Read all instructions:** Before using the battery, read all instructions and cautionary markings on the battery, the charger, and the product using the battery.
- **Charging:** Only charge the battery with the specified charger for the Parkside X 20 V Team series. Using an incompatible charger may create a risk of fire.
- Avoid short-circuiting: Do not short-circuit the battery terminals. Do not store the battery where metal objects
  could short-circuit the terminals.
- **Do not incinerate:** Do not incinerate the battery, even if it is severely damaged or completely discharged. The battery can explode in a fire.
- **Do not open:** Do not attempt to open the battery pack. There are no user-serviceable parts inside.
- **Protect from extreme conditions:** Do not expose the battery to water, rain, or extreme temperatures. Store in a dry, cool place.
- Disposal: Dispose of used batteries responsibly according to local regulations. Do not dispose of with household waste.

#### **PRODUCT OVERVIEW**

The Parkside PHSSA 20-Li A1 / PAP 20 A1 battery is a high-performance lithium-ion power source for your handheld vacuum. It features a convenient charge level indicator to monitor remaining power.

# **Key Components:**

- Battery Pack: The main power unit.
- Release Button: Used to detach the battery from the vacuum or charger.
- Charge Level Indicator: LED lights indicating the remaining battery charge.
- Contact Terminals: For connection to the vacuum and charger.

# SETUP AND INITIAL USE

# 1. Charging the Battery:

- 1. Ensure the battery is clean and dry before charging.
- 2. Connect the compatible Parkside X 20 V Team charger to a power outlet.

- 3. Slide the battery onto the charger until it clicks into place.
- 4. Monitor the charger's indicator lights for charging status. A full charge is indicated when all lights on the battery's charge level indicator are solid.
- 5. Once fully charged, disconnect the battery from the charger.

### 2. Installing the Battery:

- 1. Align the battery with the battery compartment of your Parkside PHSSA 20-Li A1 handheld vacuum.
- 2. Slide the battery firmly into the compartment until it locks securely into place with an audible click.
- 3. Gently pull on the battery to ensure it is properly seated and will not accidentally detach during use.

#### OPERATING THE BATTERY WITH YOUR DEVICE

#### **Checking Charge Level:**

Press the small button next to the LED indicators on the battery to check the current charge level. The number of illuminated LEDs indicates the approximate remaining charge:

• 3 LEDs: High charge

• 2 LEDs: Medium charge

• 1 LED: Low charge, recharge soon

• No LEDs: Battery discharged, recharge immediately

### **Using the Battery:**

Once installed, the battery powers your Parkside PHSSA 20-Li A1 handheld vacuum. Refer to your vacuum's instruction manual for specific operating procedures. When the vacuum's performance decreases, or the battery indicator shows low charge, it is time to recharge the battery.

#### **Removing the Battery:**

To remove the battery from the vacuum or charger, press and hold the red release button on the battery pack and slide the battery off.

# MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

#### Cleaning:

- · Always remove the battery from the device before cleaning.
- Wipe the battery exterior with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or immerse the battery in water.
- Keep the contact terminals clean and free of dust or debris.

#### **Storage:**

- Store the battery in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- For long-term storage, it is recommended to store the battery with a partial charge (around 50-60%) to prolong its lifespan.
- Avoid storing the battery in a completely discharged state.
- · Keep the battery away from children and pets.

# **T**ROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution	
Battery not charging.	Charger not plugged in; faulty charger; battery not properly seated; battery too hot/cold.	Check power connection; try another outlet; ensure battery is fully inserted; allow battery to reach room temperature.	
Battery not powering device.	Battery discharged; battery not properly installed; faulty battery.	Recharge battery; ensure battery is securely clicked int place; if problem persists, battery may need replacement.	
Charge indicator lights not working.	Battery fully discharged; internal fault.	Attempt to charge the battery; if still unresponsive, contact support.
