3. SETUP

3.1 Stand Assembly / Wall Mounting

Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, flat surface. Attach the stand to the TV using the provided screws, following the instructions in the separate stand assembly guide. If wall-mounting, ensure you use a compatible VESA mount and follow the mount manufacturer's instructions. Due to the TV's size and weight, it is recommended that two people handle the TV during assembly or mounting.

3.2 Connecting External Devices

- **USB Ports:** Connect USB storage devices for media playback or software updates.
- **Ethernet (LAN) Port:** For a stable wired internet connection.

- **Optical Digital Audio Out:** Connect to a soundbar or audio receiver for enhanced sound.
- **Antenna/Cable In:** Connect your antenna or cable TV feed.

Connect the power cable to the TV's power input and then to a wall outlet. Press the power button on the remote control or the TV to turn it on.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Screen Care

To clean the screen, gently wipe it with a soft, dry microfiber cloth. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-safe cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals, abrasive materials, or excessive pressure, as these can damage the OLED panel.

5.2 Burn-in Prevention

LG OLED TVs incorporate features to minimize the risk of burn-in, such as Pixel Refresher and Screen Shift. To further protect your screen:

- Avoid displaying static images or logos for extended periods.
- Utilize the TV's built-in screen saver and power-saving modes.
- Turn off the TV when not in use.

5.3 General Cleaning

Wipe the TV's frame and stand with a soft, dry cloth. Ensure the TV is unplugged before cleaning.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your LG OLED CX TV, try the following basic troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power:** Check if the power cable is securely connected to both the TV and the wall outlet. Try a different outlet.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Ensure all external devices are properly connected and powered on. Verify the correct input source is selected on the TV.
- **Remote Not Working:** Replace the batteries in the Magic Remote. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV.
- **Poor Picture Quality:** Check the picture mode settings. Ensure the content source is high-quality (e.g., 4K HDR).
- **Internet Connectivity Issues:** Check your Wi-Fi router or Ethernet cable connection. Try restarting your router.
- **Factory Reset:** As a last resort, you can perform a factory reset through the TV's settings menu. This will erase all personalized settings and data.
