2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

4. INSTALLATION

Important Safety Notice: Installation should only be performed by qualified personnel with experience in automotive transmission repair. Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) including safety glasses and gloves. Disconnect the vehicle's battery before starting any work. Refer to the vehicle manufacturer's service manual for specific transmission removal and reinstallation procedures.

4.1. Preparation

1. Ensure the transmission is clean and free of debris.

- **Transmission Fluid:** Adhere strictly to the vehicle manufacturer's recommended transmission fluid change intervals and use only specified fluid types.
- **Fluid Level Checks:** Regularly check transmission fluid levels as per the vehicle's owner's manual.
- **Inspection:** During any transmission service, inspect the kit components for signs of wear, damage, or improper seating.

Note: The kit components themselves are not typically serviceable items and are designed for replacement if damaged or worn beyond specification.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING


