1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Walker Edison 48" Solid Wood 2-Drawer Buffet. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new furniture. Please read these instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain them for future reference.

This buffet features a transitional style with two functional drawers designed to appear as four, a slatted middle shelf ideal for wine bottle storage, and a lower open shelf for additional storage or display. It is constructed from solid wood and high-grade MDF.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

To ensure safe use and prevent injury or damage, please adhere to the following safety guidelines:

- **Read All Instructions:** Familiarize yourself with all assembly steps before starting.
- **Adult Assembly Required:** This product requires adult assembly. Keep children and pets away from the assembly area.
- **Use Correct Tools:** Ensure you have the necessary tools as specified in the assembly instructions.
- **Do Not Overtighten:** Tighten all fasteners securely, but do not overtighten to avoid stripping screws or damaging components.
- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 10 pounds (approximately 4.5 kg) per shelf/drawer. Overloading can cause structural failure and injury.
- **Anti-Tip Device:** If an anti-tip device is included, it is strongly recommended to install it to prevent the unit from tipping over, especially in households with children.

- **Level Surface:** Assemble and place the buffet on a flat, level surface to ensure stability.
- **Inspect Regularly:** Periodically check all connections and fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

This buffet requires assembly. Please ensure all parts and hardware are present before beginning. A detailed assembly guide with diagrams is typically included in the product packaging. Refer to that guide for step-by-step instructions.

3.1 Unpacking and Preparation

1. Carefully unpack all components from the packaging.
2. Lay out all parts on a clean, soft surface (e.g., a blanket or carpet) to prevent scratching.
3. Verify that all parts listed in the included assembly guide are present. Contact customer support if any parts are missing or damaged.

3.2 Assembly Steps

Follow the specific diagrams and instructions provided in your product's assembly manual. General steps typically include:

- Attaching the side frames to the top panel.
- Installing the slatted middle shelf and the lower solid shelf.
- Assembling the drawers and inserting them into the buffet frame. Note that the drawers utilize wood-on-wood runners.
- Attaching the back panel (if applicable).
- Installing any anti-tip hardware.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Walker Edison buffet is designed for versatile storage and display. Here's how to utilize its features:

4.1 Drawers

The buffet features two functional drawers, designed to give the appearance of four smaller drawers. These drawers are ideal for storing smaller items such as cutlery, linens, or other household essentials.

- To open, gently pull the knob.
- To close, push the drawer firmly until it is flush with the buffet frame.
- Avoid overloading drawers to ensure smooth operation and prevent damage to the wood-on-wood runners.

4.2 Shelving

The buffet includes two open shelves for versatile storage and display.

- **Middle Slatted Shelf:** This shelf is designed with slats, making it ideal for storing wine bottles horizontally. It can also be used for other decorative items or small baskets.
- **Lower Open Shelf:** The solid lower shelf provides additional space for larger items, decorative baskets, or books.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper care will help maintain the appearance and longevity of your buffet.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or polishes that may damage the finish.
- **Spills:** Blot spills immediately with a clean, dry cloth.
- **Heat and Moisture:** Avoid placing hot items directly on the surface. Use coasters or protective pads. Protect from excessive moisture and direct sunlight.
- **Drawer Maintenance:** If drawers become stiff, a small amount of furniture wax or silicone spray applied to the wood-on-wood runners can improve smoothness.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check and tighten all screws and fasteners to ensure the buffet remains stable.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your buffet, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Wobbly or Unstable:**

Solution: Ensure the buffet is on a level surface. Check and tighten all assembly screws. If an anti-tip device is installed, ensure it is securely fastened.

- **Drawers Stick or Are Difficult to Open/Close:**

Solution: Since the drawers use wood-on-wood runners, friction can occur. Apply a small amount of furniture wax, paraffin wax, or a silicone-based lubricant to the runners on both the drawer and the buffet frame. Ensure drawers are not overloaded.

- **Missing or Damaged Parts:**

Solution: If you discover missing or damaged parts during unpacking or assembly, do not proceed with assembly. Contact Walker Edison customer support immediately for replacement parts.

- **Surface Scratches or Dents:**

Solution: For minor scratches, wood repair kits or touch-up pens matching the finish may be used. For significant damage, professional repair may be required.
