1. INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your Standard Horizon SAD-25B 110v Charger. This charger is designed to provide overnight charging for compatible Standard Horizon devices, including the HX890, HX40, and HX210 models.

2. SETUP

2.1 Unpacking and Inspection

1. Carefully remove the SAD-25B charger from its packaging.
2. Inspect the charger for any signs of damage. If damaged, do not use and contact customer support.
3. Ensure all components are present as described in the product packaging.

2.2 Connecting the Charger

1. Locate the charging port on your compatible Standard Horizon device (e.g., HX890, HX40, HX210).
2. Insert the charger's output plug firmly into the device's charging port.
3. Plug the SAD-25B charger's 110v AC plug into a standard wall outlet. Ensure the outlet is easily accessible.
4. Confirm that the device indicates it is receiving power or beginning to charge (e.g., a charging indicator light on the device).

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Charging Procedure

1. Once connected as described in Section 2.2, the charger will automatically begin providing power to your device.
2. The SAD-25B is designed for overnight charging. Allow sufficient time for your device's battery to fully charge. Refer to your device's specific user manual for typical charging times.
3. Avoid interrupting the charging cycle frequently.
4. Once the device's battery is fully charged, you may disconnect the charger from both the device and the wall outlet.

3.2 Charging Indicators

The SAD-25B charger itself does not typically feature indicator lights. Charging status is usually displayed on the connected Standard Horizon device. Consult your device's user manual for details on its charging indicator lights (e.g., solid red for charging, green for fully charged, blinking for error).

4. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Disconnect the charger from the power source and device before cleaning. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the exterior. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store the charger in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use. Avoid tangling the cable tightly.
- **Cable Care:** Do not bend or crimp the charger cable excessively. Avoid placing heavy objects on the cable.
- **Safety:** Do not attempt to open or repair the charger. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel. Keep out of reach of children.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device not charging	Charger not plugged in correctly Faulty wall outlet Device charging port issue Incompatible device	Ensure charger is fully plugged into wall and device. Try a different wall outlet. Check device's charging port for debris or damage. Verify device model is listed as compatible.
Charger feels hot	Normal operation (slight warmth) Overload or short circuit	Slight warmth is normal during charging. If excessively hot, disconnect immediately and contact support. Do not use if it smells burnt or shows signs of melting.
Charging is slow	Device battery condition Using device while charging	Battery degradation can affect charging speed over time. Avoid heavy usage of the device while it is charging for optimal speed.




