## 1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read these instructions carefully before using the appliance and keep them for future reference. Always observe basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances.

- **Electrical Safety:** Ensure the voltage indicated on the appliance matches your local power supply before connecting. Do not operate with a damaged cord or plug.
- **Placement:** Place the fan on a stable, flat surface. Do not block air inlets or outlets. Keep away from curtains, drapes, or any objects that may be drawn into the fan.
- **Water Tank:** Only fill the water tank with clean, cold tap water. Do not add essential oils, perfumes, or other chemicals to the water tank, as this may damage the humidifier function.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep the appliance out of reach of children and pets. Supervise children to ensure they do not play with the appliance.
- **Cleaning:** Always unplug the appliance before cleaning. Do not immerse the fan unit in water or other liquids.
- **Maintenance:** Do not attempt to repair the appliance yourself. Contact qualified service personnel for any repairs.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ProfiCare PC VL 3069 LB is a versatile 3-in-1 appliance combining a standing fan with an air humidifier and an ionic function for improved air quality.

### 2.1 Key Features

- **3-in-1 Functionality:** Fan, Humidifier, and Ionic Function.

- **Quiet Operation:** Designed for minimal noise, suitable for bedrooms and offices.
- **Wide Air Diffusion:** 40 cm diameter with oscillating function.
- **Adjustable Settings:** 3 fan speeds (0-1-2-3 levels), electronic timer (30 minutes to 7.30 hours), and adjustable tilt angle.
- **Humidifier:** Transparent 3-liter water tank for effective air humidification, especially in dry environments.
- **Remote Control:** Convenient operation from a distance.
- **Standby Mode:** Automatically adjusts fan speed for energy efficiency.

## 2.2 Components

Familiarize yourself with the main parts of your ProfiCare 3-in-1 fan and humidifier.

### 3. SETUP

The ProfiCare PC VL 3069 LB is designed for easy setup. No complex assembly is required.

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain the packaging for future storage or

transport.

2. **Placement:** Place the fan on a firm, level surface in the desired location. Ensure there is adequate space around the fan for air circulation and oscillation.

3. **Fill Water Tank (for Humidifier Function):**

- Remove the water tank from the base.
- Unscrew the cap at the bottom of the tank.
- Fill the tank with clean, cold tap water. Do not exceed the maximum fill line.
- Securely screw the cap back on.
- Place the filled water tank back onto the base, ensuring it is seated correctly.

4. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.

## **4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

Your ProfiCare fan can be operated using the control panel on the unit or the included remote control.

### **4.1 Control Panel and Remote Control**

The remote control provides convenient access to all functions.

- **ON/OFF:** Powers the unit on or off.
- **SPEED:** Cycles through fan speeds (0-1-2-3).

- **MODE:** Selects different fan modes (e.g., normal, natural, sleep).
- **TIME:** Sets the electronic timer for automatic shut-off (30 minutes to 7.30 hours in 30-minute increments).
- **OSC (Oscillation):** Activates or deactivates the oscillating function for wide air distribution.
- **MOIST (Humidifier):** Turns the humidifier function on or off.

## 4.2 Fan Operation

1. Press the **ON/OFF** button to turn on the fan.
2. Press the **SPEED** button repeatedly to select your desired fan speed (1, 2, or 3).
3. Press the **OSC** button to activate the oscillation feature, allowing the fan head to rotate horizontally. Press again to stop oscillation.
4. To adjust the vertical tilt angle, manually tilt the fan head to the desired position.
5. Press the **MODE** button to cycle through available fan modes. The standby mode automatically drops the fan speed and changes walking speed at irregular intervals.
6. To set a timer, press the **TIME** button repeatedly until the desired shut-off time is displayed.

## 4.3 Humidifier Operation

Ensure the water tank is filled before activating the humidifier function.

1. With the fan running, press the **MOIST** button on the control panel or remote.
2. The humidifier will begin to emit a fine mist, providing a cooling sensation and increasing air humidity.
3. To turn off the humidifier, press the **MOIST** button again.

## 5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your appliance.

### 5.1 General Cleaning

- Always unplug the fan from the power outlet before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior surfaces of the fan with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Use a vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment to remove dust from the protective grille and fan blades.

### 5.2 Humidifier Tank Cleaning

To prevent mineral buildup and maintain hygiene, clean the water tank regularly.

- Empty any remaining water from the tank.
- Rinse the tank thoroughly with clean water.
- For stubborn mineral deposits, use a solution of white vinegar and water (1:1 ratio). Let it soak for 20-30 minutes, then rinse thoroughly.
- Ensure the tank is completely dry before refilling or storing.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ProfiCare fan, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not turn on.	No power supply.	Check if the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet.
No mist from humidifier.	Water tank is empty or not properly seated.	Refill the water tank and ensure it is correctly placed on the base.
Weak airflow.	Fan speed is too low or air inlets/outlets are blocked.	Increase the fan speed. Clear any obstructions from the fan's grilles.
Unusual noise.	Loose parts or foreign objects.	Unplug the fan and check for any loose components or objects caught in the blades.
Remote control not working.	Batteries are dead or incorrectly inserted.	Replace the remote control batteries (1 A battery required, included). Ensure correct polarity.
