1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Gateman WV-43 is an advanced digital door lock system designed to provide secure and convenient access to your property. It features an intuitive LED touch keypad and supports card key authentication, offering multiple methods for entry. This manual provides essential information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your Gateman WV-43 digital door lock.

2. COMPONENTS INCLUDED

Upon unpacking your Gateman WV-43 digital door lock, please verify that all the following components are present:

- Front Body (Exterior Unit)
- Main Body (Interior Unit)
- Main Bracket
- Strike Plate
- Korean Manual (Please refer to this English manual for instructions)

- 4 Card Keys
- Construction Paper (for installation template)
- 4 Batteries (AA size, typically)
- Skew (Installation Screws/Hardware)
- Product Warranty Information
- Alarm Sticker

3. KEY FEATURES

The Gateman WV-43 digital door lock incorporates several features designed for security, convenience, and durability:

- **Elegant and Simple Design:** Aesthetically pleasing design that complements various door styles.
- **Waterproof Functionality:** Designed to withstand environmental elements.
- **Imaginary Password Function:** Enhances security by allowing users to enter random numbers before and after their actual password, preventing pattern recognition from smudges.

- **Automatic/Manual Lock Number:** Provides flexibility for automatic locking or manual control.
- **Residual Fingerprint Prevention Function:** Minimizes the visibility of frequently touched numbers on the keypad, reducing the risk of password discovery.

- **2-Way Authentication Method:** Supports multiple authentication methods for enhanced security.
- **3-Minute Lock Function:** A security feature that temporarily disables the keypad after multiple incorrect entry attempts.

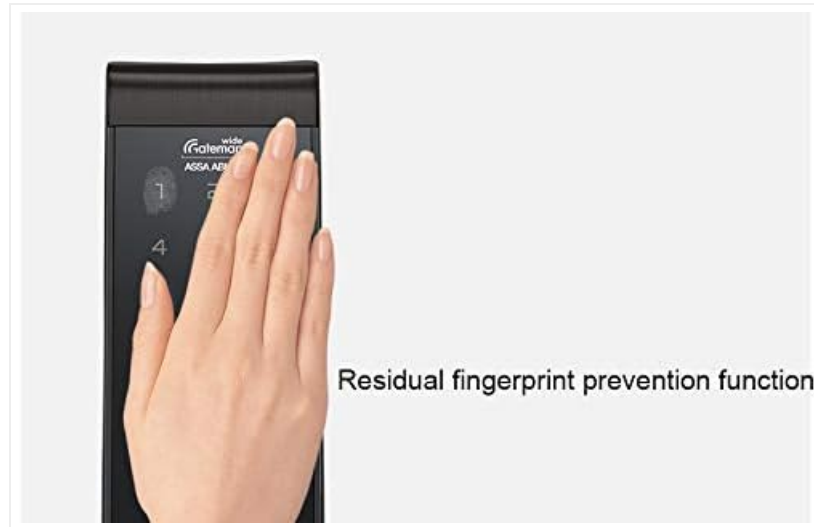


Image 3.3: The lock supports 2-way authentication (e.g., card key and PIN) and features a 3-minute lock after incorrect attempts.

- **Safety System with Electric Shock and High-Temperature Alarm:** Integrated safety features to protect against tampering and fire hazards.
- **Alarm for Damage and Intrusion:** Alerts users to attempted forced entry or damage to the lock.
- **Emergency Power Function:** Allows temporary power supply in case of battery depletion.

4. INSTALLATION AND SETUP

Proper installation is crucial for the optimal performance and security of your digital door lock. It is highly recommended to consult a professional for installation if you are unfamiliar with door lock mechanisms.

4.1 Door Compatibility Check

Before installation, ensure your door is compatible with the Gateman WV-43. Different door types and existing lock configurations may require specific installation procedures or additional components. Please refer to the compatibility guide below.

4.2 Initial Setup (Battery Installation)

1. Open the battery cover on the interior unit.
2. Insert the 4 AA batteries provided, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
3. Close the battery cover securely.
4. The lock will typically emit a sound or light to indicate successful power-on.

4.3 Programming Passwords and Card Keys

Refer to the detailed programming instructions in the Korean manual for specific steps on setting up your master password, user passwords, and registering card keys. Generally, this involves pressing a registration button on the interior unit and then following prompts on the exterior keypad.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Opening the Door (Exterior)

• Using a Password:

- a. Touch the keypad to activate it.
- b. Enter your registered password, optionally preceded and followed by random numbers (Imaginary Password Function).
- c. Press the '*' or '#' key (depending on model configuration) to confirm.
- d. The door will unlock.

• Using a Card Key:

- a. Touch the keypad to activate it.

- b. Place your registered card key on the card reader area of the exterior unit.
- c. The door will unlock.

5.2 Locking the Door

- **Automatic Locking:** If configured for automatic locking, the door will lock itself a few seconds after closing.
- **Manual Locking (Exterior):** Touch the keypad to activate it, then press the '*' or '#' key (depending on model configuration) to manually lock the door.
- **Manual Locking (Interior):** Turn the manual lock knob on the interior unit to the locked position.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and proper functioning of your Gateman WV-43 digital door lock, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior keypad with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, solvents, or excessive moisture, as these can damage the electronic components.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace all four AA batteries when the low battery indicator appears or when the lock's operation becomes sluggish. Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries.
- **Avoid Force:** Do not apply excessive force to the keypad or the door handle.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Gateman WV-43, consider the following common solutions:

- **Lock Not Responding:** Check the batteries. If they are low or depleted, replace them. Ensure the emergency power function is used if batteries are completely dead.
- **Keypad Not Lighting Up:** Tap the keypad to activate it. If it still doesn't light up, check battery connections or replace batteries.
- **Door Not Locking/Unlocking:** Ensure the door is fully closed and aligned with the strike plate. Check for any obstructions. Verify that the correct password or registered card key is being used.
- **Alarm Sounds:** Identify the type of alarm (e.g., intrusion, high temperature, tampering) and take appropriate action. Refer to the full manual for specific alarm codes if available.
- **3-Minute Lock Activated:** Wait for the lockout period to expire before attempting to enter the password again.

If problems persist, contact customer support or a qualified technician.

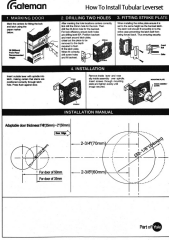

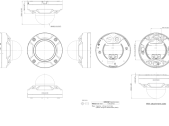
