1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Read all instructions carefully before using the microwave oven. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Do not operate the oven if the door is open or damaged.
- Do not place any metal objects, aluminum foil, or metal-trimmed dishes in the microwave.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the oven. Do not block air vents.
- Supervise children closely when the microwave is in use.
- Do not heat liquids in sealed containers, as they may explode.
- Never attempt to repair or modify the oven yourself. Contact qualified service personnel.
- Always use microwave-safe cookware.
- Do not use the microwave for purposes other than heating food.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Emjoi UEMO-6030DG is a 30-liter, 900-watt countertop microwave oven designed for efficient heating and defrosting of various food items. Its user-friendly button controls make operation simple and convenient.

3. SETUP

3.1 Unpacking

- Carefully remove the microwave oven and all packing materials from the carton.
- Check the oven for any damage, such as dents or a misaligned door. Do not operate if damaged.
- Remove any protective film from the cabinet surface.
- Ensure the glass turntable and turntable ring assembly are present and undamaged.

3.2 Placement

- Place the oven on a flat, stable surface strong enough to support its weight.
- Ensure at least 20 cm (8 inches) of space above the oven, 10 cm (4 inches) at the rear, and 5 cm (2 inches) on both sides for proper ventilation.
- Do not place the oven near heat sources or in damp areas.

3.3 Power Connection

- Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet. Ensure the voltage matches the rating label on the oven.
- Do not use extension cords or adapters.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Basic Heating

1. Place food in a microwave-safe container on the glass turntable.
2. Close the oven door securely.
3. Use the control buttons to set the desired cooking time and power level. Refer to the control panel for specific button functions.
4. Press the 'Start' button to begin cooking.
5. The oven will beep when cooking is complete. Carefully remove the food, as the container may be hot.

4.2 Defrost Function

The defrost feature allows for quick and even thawing of frozen foods.

1. Place the frozen food in a microwave-safe dish.
2. Select the 'Defrost' function using the control panel.
3. Enter the weight of the food or the desired defrost time, depending on the model's specific controls.
4. Press 'Start'. The oven may pause during defrosting to allow you to turn or separate food items for more even thawing.

4.3 Setting Cooking Time and Power Level

- **Time Setting:** Use the time adjustment buttons (e.g., 'Min', 'Sec', or a dial) to set the desired cooking duration.
- **Power Level:** Most models offer multiple power levels. Select the appropriate power level for your food (e.g., 100% for fast heating, 50% for simmering).

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning helps maintain the performance and longevity of your microwave oven.

- **Interior Cleaning:** Wipe the interior with a damp cloth and mild detergent after each use. For stubborn

stains, place a bowl of water with lemon slices inside and heat for 2-3 minutes to loosen residue, then wipe clean.

- **Exterior Cleaning:** Clean the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- **Turntable and Ring:** The glass turntable and turntable ring can be removed and washed in warm, soapy water or in a dishwasher. Ensure they are dry before placing them back in the oven.
- **Door Seals:** Keep the door seals clean to ensure a proper seal during operation.
- Always unplug the microwave before cleaning.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your microwave, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven does not start	Power cord not plugged in; Door not closed properly; Fuse blown or circuit breaker tripped.	Plug in power cord; Close door firmly; Check household fuse or reset circuit breaker.
Food not heating	Door not closed properly; Cooking time or power level set incorrectly; Food not microwave-safe.	Ensure door is closed; Adjust time/power; Use microwave-safe cookware.
Sparking inside oven	Metal or foil in oven; Food residue on cavity walls.	Remove metal objects; Clean oven interior thoroughly.
Turntable not rotating	Turntable not properly seated; Turntable motor malfunction.	Ensure turntable and ring are correctly positioned; Contact service if issue persists.
