1. INTRODUCTION TO THE TM2119CD MANUAL

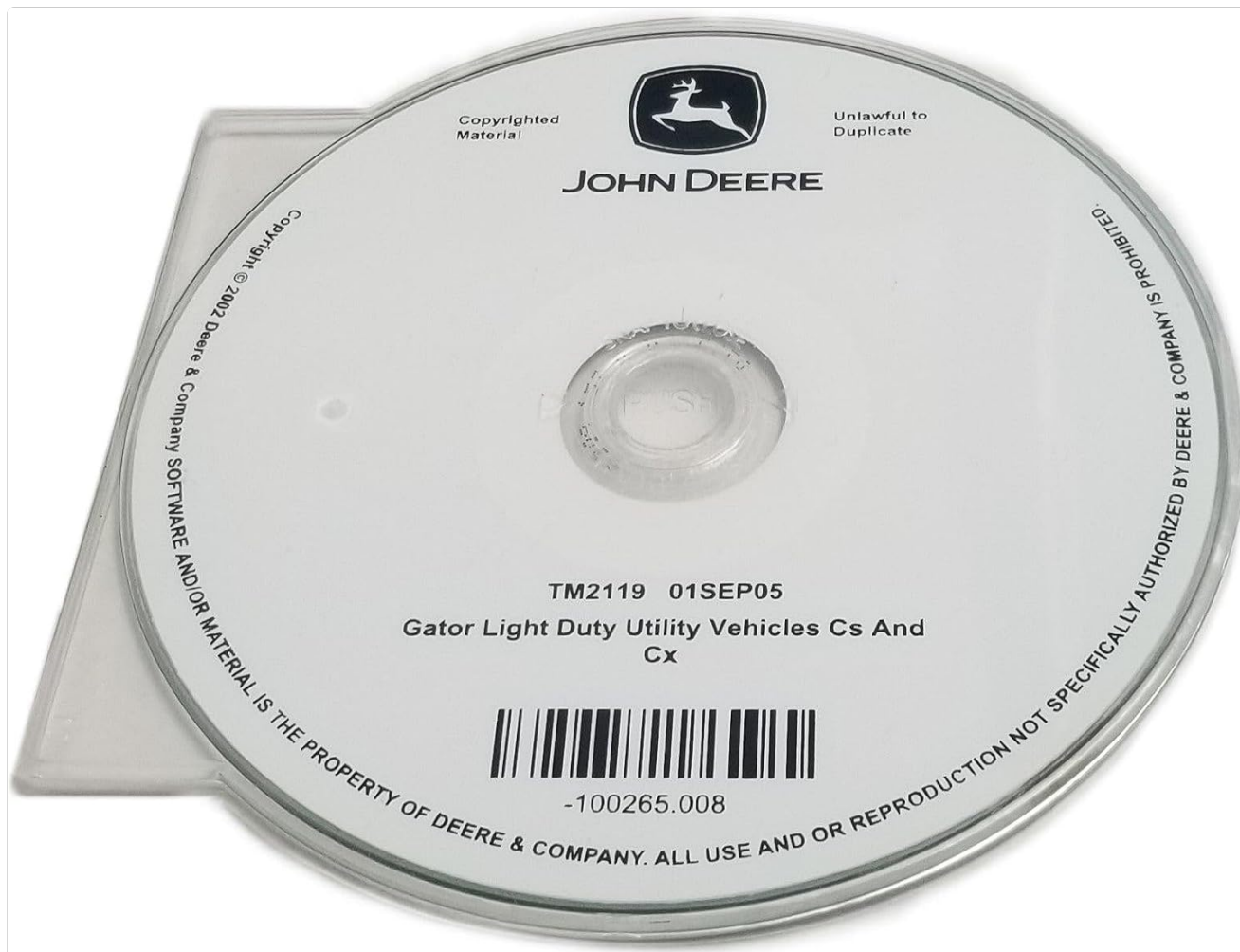

2. SETUP AND SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

To access the content of the TM2119CD, a computer with a CD-ROM drive is required. The manual is an electronic document, typically in a Portable Document Format (PDF) or similar, which can be viewed using standard document reader software.

2.1. Minimum System Requirements

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues while using the TM2119CD, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **CD Not Recognized:**
 - Ensure the CD is inserted correctly into the drive.
 - Check if the CD-ROM drive is functioning correctly with other discs.
 - Clean the CD surface for any smudges or dirt.
