MODEL: FUN SP

1. Product Overview

The Signia Fun SP is a Behind-The-Ear (BTE) hearing aid designed for individuals with severe to profound hearing loss. It offers high amplification, outstanding comfort, and features like noise management and four sound profiles to enhance your listening experience. Its intuitive rocker switch allows for easy volume adjustments and sound profile selection.

2. Setup and First Use

2.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure the following items are present:

- Signia Fun SP Hearing Aid
- Battery case
- D-dry unit (if included)
- Manuals and books

2.2 Battery Insertion

The Signia Fun SP uses specific hearing aid batteries. To insert a battery:

1. Open the battery compartment door gently.
2. Insert the new battery with the positive (+) side facing the correct orientation, usually indicated by a symbol inside the compartment.
3. Close the battery compartment door firmly until it clicks. The hearing aid will typically power on automatically.

2.3 Initial Fitting

For optimal performance and comfort, professional fitting by a hearing care specialist is recommended. They will adjust the hearing aid to your specific hearing needs based on your audiology report. Before purchase, it is essential to consult with a specialist to determine the best option for you.

3. Operating Instructions

3.1 Powering On/Off

To power on the hearing aid, ensure the battery compartment is fully closed. To power off, gently open the battery compartment door.

3.2 Volume Adjustment

The Signia Fun SP features a convenient rocker switch for volume control:

- Press the upper part of the rocker switch to increase the volume.
- Press the lower part of the rocker switch to decrease the volume.

3.3 Sound Profiles

The Fun SP offers 4 sound profiles to adapt to different listening environments. Your optimum sound profile can be set with a simple press on the rocker switch. Consult your hearing care professional for details on how to cycle through these profiles and their specific uses.

4. Care and Maintenance

4.1 Daily Cleaning

Regular cleaning is crucial for maintaining the performance and longevity of your hearing aid:

- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the hearing aid daily.
- Use the provided cleaning tools (brush, wax pick) to remove any wax or debris from the ear mold and sound outlet.
- Avoid using water, solvents, or cleaning fluids, as these can damage the device.

4.2 Battery Care

To maximize battery life and ensure consistent performance:

- Always use fresh batteries of the correct type.
- Open the battery compartment door when the hearing aid is not in use (e.g., overnight) to conserve battery life and allow moisture to escape.
- Store spare batteries in a cool, dry place, away from children and pets.

4.3 Storage

When not in use, store your hearing aid in its protective case or a dedicated drying kit (like the D-dry unit) to protect it from moisture and physical damage.

---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound or weak sound	Dead or low battery Blocked sound outlet/earmold Volume too low	Replace battery Clean sound outlet/earmold Increase volume using rocker switch
Whistling or feedback	Improper fit Excessive earwax Hand/object too close to hearing aid	Reinsert hearing aid properly Consult doctor for earwax removal Adjust position of hand/object
Sound is distorted or unclear	Low battery Moisture in hearing aid Damaged component	Replace battery Use drying kit Contact service center


7.1 Warranty Information
