1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the use and maintenance of your Easytry123 Universal Remote Control. This remote is designed as a direct infrared (IR) replacement for various JVC LCD LED HDTV TV models, including RM-C13G1H, RM-C14G, RM-C14G1H, RM-C15G, RM-C15G1H, RM-C18G, RM-C18G1H, RM-C18G1HNP, and RM-C203. It is intended to function immediately upon battery installation, without the need for complex programming, provided your original remote matches the appearance of this replacement.

Please ensure your original remote control is identical in appearance to the remote shown in this manual for guaranteed compatibility and full functionality. While designed as a direct replacement, some advanced or specific functions present on your original remote may not be fully replicated.

2. SPECIFICATIONS

- **Power Source:** 2 x AAA Batteries (not included)

3. SETUP: BATTERY INSTALLATION

The remote control requires two AAA batteries for operation. Please follow these steps to install the batteries correctly:

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
2. Gently slide the battery cover downwards or press the latch (if present) and lift to open the compartment.
3. Insert two AAA batteries, ensuring that the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the markings inside the compartment. Incorrect insertion can prevent the remote from functioning.
4. Replace the battery cover by sliding it back into place until it clicks securely.

Once batteries are installed, the remote control should be ready for use with your compatible JVC television.

4. BASIC OPERATION

This replacement remote control is designed to mimic the functions of your original JVC remote. Point the remote directly at your television's IR receiver for optimal performance. Below are common buttons and their general functions:

Common Button Functions

Button Name	Function
POWER	Turns the television on or off.
INPUT / SOURCE	Cycles through available input sources (e.g., HDMI, AV, Component).
CH +/- (Channel Up/Down)	Changes the television channel up or down.
VOL +/- (Volume Up/Down)	Adjusts the television's volume level.
MUTE	Mutes or unmutes the television's audio.
MENU	Opens the television's on-screen menu.

Button Name	Function
Navigation Buttons (Up, Down, Left, Right, OK)	Used to navigate through menus and confirm selections.
Number Buttons (0-9)	Directly enter channel numbers.
BACK / EXIT	Returns to the previous screen or exits the current menu.
INFO / GUIDE	Displays program information or the electronic program guide.

For specific functions not listed, refer to your television's original user manual, as this remote is designed to replicate the original's functionality.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If your remote control is not functioning as expected, please try the following troubleshooting steps:

- **Remote Not Responding:**
 - Ensure batteries are inserted correctly with the correct polarity (+/-).
 - Replace old or depleted batteries with new AAA batteries.
 - Check for any obstructions between the remote control and the television's IR receiver.
 - Ensure you are pointing the remote directly at the television.
- **Certain Functions Not Working:**
 - This remote is a direct replacement. If your original remote had unique or advanced features, this replacement may not support them fully.
 - Verify that your television model is listed as compatible. If your model is not included in the product title, functionality may be limited or non-existent.

6. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and proper functioning of your remote control, please observe the following:




- **Cleaning:** Wipe the remote control with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or chemical agents, as these can damage the surface or internal components.
- **Storage:** Store the remote in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- **Battery Removal:** If the remote control will not be used for an extended period (e.g., one month or more), remove the batteries to prevent leakage and potential damage to the remote.
- **Avoid Drops:** Protect the remote from physical shocks and drops, which can damage internal circuitry.
