PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The BLACK+DECKER Bug Zapper Electric Lantern is designed to attract and eliminate various flying insects such as flies, mosquitoes, gnats, and wasps. Utilizing UV technology, it provides an efficient and safe solution for pest control in both indoor and outdoor environments. This product is suitable for use around children and pets.

Key features include a durable, waterproof design, a convenient removable insect tray for easy cleaning, and a built-in ring with a provided chain for versatile hanging or standing placement.

SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the bug zapper and all accessories from the packaging. Ensure all components, including the unit, hanging chain, and cleaning brush, are present.
2. **Placement Options:**
 - **Hanging:** Attach the provided chain to the built-in ring at the top of the zapper. Hang the unit from a secure hook, tree branch, awning, or other suitable overhead structure.
 - **Standing:** Place the zapper on a stable, flat surface such as a table or patio floor. Ensure the surface is level to prevent the unit from tipping over.
3. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a standard electrical outlet. The unit is designed for plug-in operation.
4. **Optimal Positioning:** For best results, position the bug zapper approximately 6-8 feet away from areas where people gather, as it is designed to attract insects.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The BLACK+DECKER Bug Zapper operates continuously once plugged in. It uses UV light to attract insects, which are then eliminated upon contact with the internal electric grid. The unit is designed for both day and night use.

- **Activation:** Simply plug the unit into a suitable electrical outlet. The UV light will illuminate, indicating that the zapper is active and ready to attract insects.
- **Coverage:** Each unit covers an area of up to 625 square feet. For larger areas or increased effectiveness, multiple units can be deployed.
- **Safety:** The zapper features a clog-resistant grid designed to allow both small and large insects to enter while maintaining safety for users. It is safe to use around children and pets.

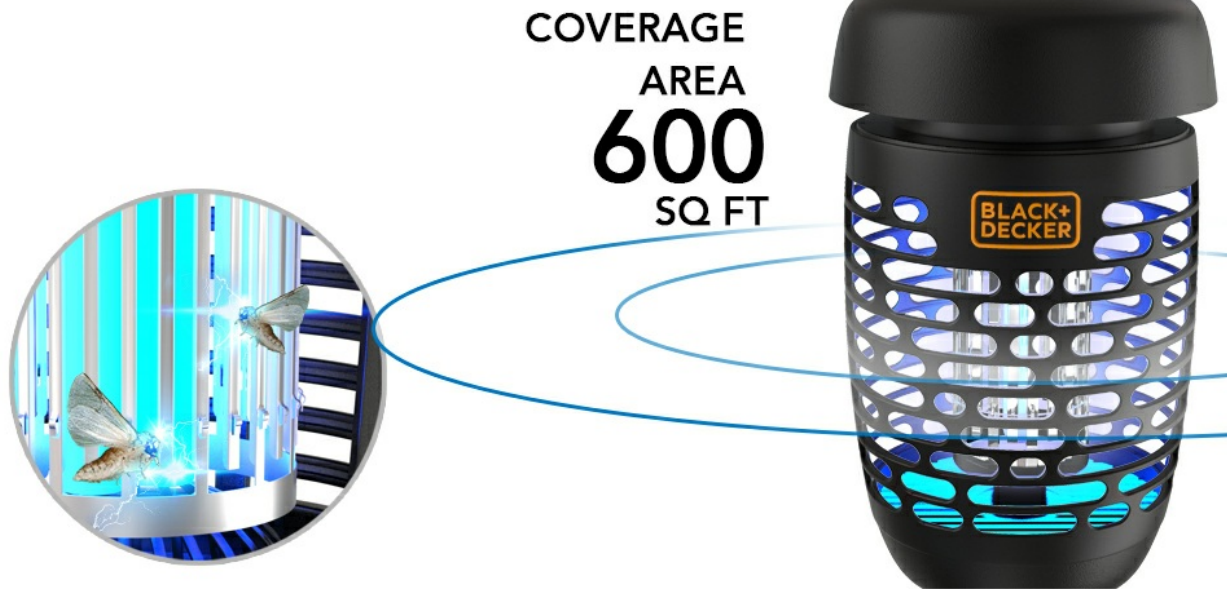

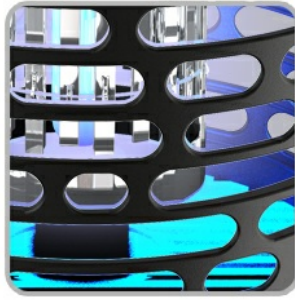
MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning of your bug zapper is essential to ensure optimal performance and longevity. Always unplug the unit before performing any maintenance.

- 1. Emptying the Collection Tray:** The bug zapper features a convenient removable tray at the bottom to collect dead insects.
 - Unplug the unit from the power source.
 - Gently twist or slide out the collection tray from the bottom of the unit.
 - Discard the collected insects.
 - Reinsert the tray securely into the unit.
- 2. Cleaning the Grid:** A bonus cleaning brush is included to help remove any excess waste or debris from the electric grid.
 - Ensure the unit is unplugged.
 - Use the provided cleaning brush to gently scrub away any insects or residue stuck to the internal grid. Do not use water or cleaning solutions on the grid.
 - Tap the unit gently to dislodge any remaining debris into the collection tray.
- 3. Bulb Replacement:** The UV light bulb is replaceable, ensuring many years of effective use. Refer to the product packaging or manufacturer's website for compatible replacement bulbs and detailed replacement instructions.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on / Light does not illuminate.	- Not plugged in correctly. - Power outlet is not functioning. - UV bulb is burnt out or loose.	- Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet. - Test the outlet with another appliance. - Unplug the unit, check if the bulb is securely seated. If not, replace the bulb.
Insects are not being zapped or effectiveness is low.	- Electric grid is clogged with dead insects. - Unit is placed too close to human activity or other light sources. - UV bulb is old and losing effectiveness.	- Unplug the unit and clean the electric grid using the provided brush. - Relocate the zapper 6-8 feet away from areas where people gather and away from competing light sources. - Consider replacing the UV bulb if it has been in use for an extended period.
Loud popping sounds.	Large insects being zapped.	This is normal operation when larger insects come into contact with the grid. No action required.
