1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Mac Allister 18V Cordless Impact Drill MSCD18-Li-2. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new tool. Please read these instructions carefully before use and keep them for future reference.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always observe basic safety precautions to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and personal injury. Familiarize yourself with all safety warnings and instructions provided.

- **Work Area Safety:** Keep the work area clean and well-lit. Cluttered or dark areas invite accidents.
- **Electrical Safety:** Do not expose power tools to rain or wet conditions. Water entering a power tool will increase the risk of electric shock.
- **Personal Safety:** Always wear eye protection. Use hearing protection when operating impact drills. Dress properly; avoid loose clothing or jewelry.
- **Tool Use and Care:** Do not force the power tool. Use the correct power tool for your application. Disconnect the battery pack from the power tool before making any adjustments, changing accessories, or storing power tools.
- **Battery Pack Use and Care:** Recharge only with the charger specified by the manufacturer. Do not use battery packs with any other power tools.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your Mac Allister 18V Cordless Impact Drill.

1. **Keyless Chuck:** For quick and easy bit changes.
2. **Torque Adjustment Ring:** To select the desired torque setting or drilling mode.
3. **Gear Selector:** For high or low speed settings.
4. **Forward/Reverse Switch:** To change rotation direction.
5. **Trigger Switch:** To activate the tool and control speed.
6. **Handle:** Ergonomic grip for comfortable use.
7. **Battery Pack:** Detachable 18V Lithium-ion battery.

5. SETUP

5.1 Battery Charging

1. Connect the charger to a suitable power outlet.
2. Slide the battery pack onto the charger until it clicks into place.
3. The charging indicator light will show the charging status. Refer to the charger manual for specific light patterns.
4. Once fully charged, remove the battery pack from the charger.

5.2 Battery Installation and Removal

- **Installation:** Align the battery pack with the base of the drill handle and slide it in until it locks securely.
- **Removal:** Press the battery release button (if present) and slide the battery pack out.

5.3 Attaching Accessories (Drill Bits/Screwdriver Bits)

1. Ensure the drill is switched off and the battery is removed.
2. Hold the rear part of the chuck and rotate the front part counter-clockwise to open the jaws.
3. Insert the drill bit or screwdriver bit into the chuck as far as it will go.
4. Rotate the front part of the chuck clockwise to tighten the jaws securely around the bit.

5. Always ensure the bit is centered and firmly secured before operation.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Selecting Operating Mode and Torque

Rotate the torque adjustment ring to select the desired mode:

- **Screwdriving Mode:** Use settings 1-X (numbers) for various torque levels. Lower numbers for smaller screws/softer materials, higher numbers for larger screws/harder materials.
- **Drilling Mode:** Select the drill symbol for general drilling without impact.
- **Impact Drilling Mode:** Select the hammer symbol for drilling into masonry or concrete.

6.2 Speed Selection

Use the gear selector switch on top of the drill:

- **Gear 1 (Low Speed):** For high torque applications like screwdriving or drilling large holes.
- **Gear 2 (High Speed):** For faster drilling of smaller holes.

6.3 Forward/Reverse Rotation

Push the forward/reverse switch to the left for forward rotation (drilling/screwing in) or to the right for reverse rotation (removing screws/bits).

6.4 Starting and Stopping

- **To Start:** Press the trigger switch. The speed is variable depending on how far the trigger is pressed.
- **To Stop:** Release the trigger switch.

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1 Cleaning

- Keep the ventilation slots of the tool clean to prevent overheating.
- Wipe the tool housing with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

7.2 Storage

- Store the tool and battery in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and moisture.
- Ensure the battery is partially charged before long-term storage.

7.3 Battery Care

- Do not store batteries in discharged condition.
- Avoid exposing batteries to extreme temperatures.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Drill does not start	Battery not charged or improperly installed	Charge battery; ensure it is securely installed.
Loss of power during operation	Battery charge low	Recharge the battery.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Excessive vibration or noise	Loose bit or damaged accessory	Check bit for secure fit; replace damaged accessories.
Drill overheats	Blocked ventilation slots; prolonged heavy use	Clean ventilation slots; allow tool to cool down.
