1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The BUTFULAKE GH1 Gaming Headset is designed to provide an immersive audio experience for gamers across various platforms. Featuring 50mm magnetic neodymium drivers, a noise-cancelling microphone, and comfortable over-ear design, this headset aims to enhance your gaming sessions with clear sound and communication.

2. KEY FEATURES

- **Clear & Accurate Positional Audio:** Equipped with 50mm Magnetic Neodymium drivers for a wider soundscape and precise positional audio, allowing detection of in-game actions from various directions.
- **Powerful Bass & Surround Sound Audio:** Simulates 360-degree positional surround sound for realistic depth, ensuring every sound detail is heard.
- **Long-Lasting Comfort:** Lightweight design with an adjustable headband and soft, deep ear cushions made of breathable leatherette to effectively release heat and pressure, providing comfort and sound isolation for extended use.
- **Multi-Platform Compatibility:** Features a 2-meter 3.5mm audio cable, compatible with PS series controllers, Xbox One series controllers, Nintendo Switch, PC, cell phones, and tablets. *Note: An extra Microsoft adapter may be required for*

older Xbox controllers.

- **Easy Volume Control:** Includes an analog volume control wheel and a microphone mute switch on the cable. The USB connection is solely for LED light effects and does not transmit sound.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please verify that all items are present in your package:

- BUTFULAKE GH1 Gaming Headset (with integrated 3.5mm audio cable, USB cable for LED, and in-line control)
- Y-Splitter Adapter (for PC connection)

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to connect your BUTFULAKE GH1 Gaming Headset to your device:

1. Connecting to PS4/PS5, Xbox One (New Version), Nintendo Switch, Mobile/Tablet:

Plug the 3.5mm jack of the headset directly into the controller (PS4/PS5, Xbox One) or the device's audio port (Nintendo Switch, Mobile/Tablet).

2. Connecting to Xbox One (Old Version):

An additional Microsoft adapter (not included) is required to connect the 3.5mm jack to older Xbox One controllers that lack a built-in 3.5mm interface.

3. Connecting to PC/Laptop:

Use the included Y-Splitter Adapter. Connect the headset's 3.5mm jack to the Y-splitter, then plug the green connector of the Y-splitter into your PC's headphone jack and the pink connector into your PC's microphone jack. Ensure both the headset microphone and computer microphone settings are enabled in your system's audio preferences.

4. Powering LED Lights:

Plug the USB connector into any available USB port on your console, PC, or a USB power adapter. This USB connection is solely for powering the blue LED lights on the headset and does not transmit audio.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once connected, operate your headset using the in-line controls:

- **Volume Control Wheel:** Located on the in-line control unit. Rotate the wheel up to increase volume and down to decrease volume.
- **Microphone Mute Switch:** Also on the in-line control unit. Slide the switch to mute or unmute the microphone.
- **Adjusting the Microphone:** The microphone arm is flexible and can be adjusted 120 degrees to position it optimally for voice pickup.

- **Wearing the Headset:** Adjust the headband to fit comfortably on your head. The soft memory earmuffs are designed to provide comfort and sound isolation.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your headset, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the headset. For the ear cushions, a slightly damp cloth can be used, but ensure they are completely dry before use. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid tangling the cables.
- **Handling:** Do not pull on the cables to disconnect the headset. Always grasp the plug firmly. Avoid dropping or subjecting the headset to strong impacts.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your BUTFULAKE GH1 Gaming Headset, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from headset	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Volume too low or muted• Incorrect audio output selected• Loose connection	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Increase volume using in-line control or device settings.• Check device's audio settings to ensure headset is selected as output.• Ensure 3.5mm jack is fully inserted.
Microphone not working	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Microphone muted• Incorrect audio input selected• Loose connection• Old Xbox controller without adapter	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Unmute microphone using in-line switch.• Check device's audio settings to ensure headset mic is selected as input.• Ensure 3.5mm jack is fully inserted.• For PC, ensure Y-splitter is correctly connected and both mic/headset inputs are enabled.• For old Xbox controllers, ensure Microsoft adapter is used.
LED lights not working	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• USB not connected or faulty port	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure USB plug is fully inserted into a working USB port.• Try a different USB port.
Sound quality is poor or distorted	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Loose connection• Device audio settings	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure 3.5mm jack is fully inserted.• Adjust device's audio settings (e.g., equalizer, sound enhancements).• Test on another device to rule out device-specific issues.
