## INTRODUCTION TO UNO POKÉMON

---

The Mattel UNO Pokémon Card Game (Model B7696) combines the classic UNO gameplay with beloved Pokémon characters. This edition includes 112 cards, featuring various Pokémon such as Salnori, Hibany, Messon, Zashian, Zamentha, Mewtwo, and Victorini, along with special rule cards like "Snorlagon" and "Gekuga" to enhance your game experience. This manual provides instructions for setup, gameplay, and care.

## GAME SETUP

1. **Unpack the Cards:** Carefully remove all 112 cards from the packaging.

2. **Identify Card Types:** Familiarize yourself with the different types of cards: number cards (0-9 in four colors), Draw Two, Reverse, Skip, Wild, Wild Draw Four, and the special Pokémon rule cards.
3. **Shuffle the Deck:** Thoroughly shuffle the entire deck of 112 cards.
4. **Deal Starting Hands:** Deal 7 cards face down to each player.
5. **Form the Draw Pile:** Place the remaining cards face down to form the Draw Pile.
6. **Start the Discard Pile:** Turn the top card of the Draw Pile face up and place it next to the Draw Pile to start the Discard Pile. If the first card is a special action card (e.g., Wild, Draw Two), refer to the official UNO rules for starting play with such cards.

## GAMEPLAY INSTRUCTIONS

---

The objective of UNO Pokémon is to be the first player to empty your hand of cards. Players take turns matching the top card of the Discard Pile by color, number, or symbol.

- **Matching Cards:** On your turn, you must play a card from your hand that matches the color, number, or symbol of the top card on the Discard Pile.
- **Drawing Cards:** If you cannot play a card, you must draw one card from the Draw Pile. If the drawn card can be played, you may play it immediately. Otherwise, your turn ends.
- **Action Cards:**
  - **Skip:** The next player in sequence loses their turn.
  - **Reverse:** Reverses the direction of play.
  - **Draw Two:** The next player must draw two cards and loses their turn.
  - **Wild Card:** Allows the player to change the color of play.
  - **Wild Draw Four:** Allows the player to change the color and the next player must draw four cards and loses their turn. This card can only be played if you have no other card in your hand that

matches the color of the previous card played.

- **Calling "UNO!":** When you play your second-to-last card, you must immediately shout "UNO!" If you fail to do so and another player catches you before the next player takes their turn, you must draw two cards.
- **Winning the Round:** The first player to play their last card wins the round. Points are then tallied based on the cards remaining in other players' hands.

## SPECIAL POKÉMON RULE CARDS

---

This UNO Pokémon edition includes unique special rule cards that add an extra layer of strategy and fun to the game:

- **Snorlagon Card:** This special card introduces a unique rule. When played, all other players must draw 3 cards. This card can be played on any turn, regardless of the color or number of the previous card.
- **Gekuga Card:** The Gekuga card allows the player who plays it to choose another player. The chosen player must then discard all cards of a specific color (chosen by the player who played Gekuga) from their hand. This card can be played on any turn.

- **Handling:** Handle cards with clean, dry hands to avoid smudges and wear.
- **Avoid Liquids:** Keep cards away from liquids and moisture to prevent damage.
- **Cleaning:** Do not wash or immerse cards in water. If a card gets dirty, gently wipe it with a dry, soft cloth.



