1. Introduction

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your FILA Digital Quartz Watch, Model 38-105-005. This digital watch features a durable ABS case, a comfortable silicone strap, and is designed for everyday use with 5 ATM water resistance. It includes functions such as time, date, and world time, along with an EL backlight for visibility. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper use and to maximize the lifespan of your watch.

2. KEY FEATURES

- **Digital Display:** Clear digital readout for time, date, and other functions.

3. WATCH COMPONENTS

4. SETUP AND BASIC OPERATION

4.1 Setting Time and Date

- 1. Press the **Bottom Left Button** repeatedly to cycle through modes until the time setting mode is displayed (usually indicated by flashing digits).
- 2. Use the Bottom Right Button to adjust the flashing digit (hours, minutes, year, month, day).
- 3. Press the **Bottom Left Button** again to move to the next setting parameter.
- 4. Once all settings are complete, press the **Bottom Left Button** to exit the setting mode.

4.2 Using the Backlight

To illuminate the display in low-light conditions, press the **Top Left Button**. The backlight will remain active for a few seconds.

4.3 World Time Function

To access the World Time feature, press the **Top Right Button**. Repeated presses will cycle through the 25 pre-programmed city times. To return to the home time display, continue pressing the **Top Right Button** until your desired home city is shown, or switch modes using the **Bottom Left Button**.

5. MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Wipe the watch case and strap with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Water Resistance: The watch is 5 ATM water resistant. This means it can withstand splashes, rain, and brief immersion in shallow water. Do not operate buttons while the watch is wet or submerged. Avoid hot water, steam, and prolonged exposure to water.
- **Battery Replacement:** When the display dims or functions become erratic, the battery may need replacement. This should be performed by a qualified watch technician to ensure water resistance is maintained.
- Storage: Store the watch in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Display is blank or dim.	Low or depleted battery.	Replace the battery.
Buttons are unresponsive.	Watch may be in a locked mode or internal malfunction.	Try resetting the watch (if applicable, refer to specific model reset instructions) or contact support.
Time is incorrect.	Time not set correctly or accidental adjustment.	Refer to Section 4.1 "Setting Time and Date" to readjust.
Condensation inside display.	Exposure to extreme temperature changes or water ingress.	Avoid extreme temperature changes. If condensation persists, seek professional service.
