JBL Tune 560BT Wireless Headphones User Manual

1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the JBL Tune 560BT Wireless Headphones. This user manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your headphones to ensure optimal performance and longevity. Please read this manual thoroughly before using your device.

2. What's in the Box

Upon unboxing your JBL Tune 560BT headphones, please verify that all the following items are present:

- JBL Tune 560BT Wireless Headphones
- Charging Cable (USB-A to Micro-USB)
- Quick Start Guide
- Safety Sheet
- Warranty Card

3. Product Overview

The JBL Tune 560BT are supraaural (on-ear) wireless headphones designed for comfort and high-quality audio. They feature a foldable design for easy portability and intuitive controls located on the earcup.

Controls and Indicators:

- **Power Button:** Located on the right earcup, used for turning the headphones on/off and initiating Bluetooth pairing.
- **Volume Buttons (+/-):** Adjusts audio volume.
- **Multi-function Button:** Controls music playback (play/pause, skip tracks) and call management (answer/end calls).
- **Micro-USB Port:** For charging the headphones.
- **LED Indicator:** Displays battery status and pairing mode.
- **Microphone:** Built-in for hands-free calls and voice assistant activation.

4. Setup

4.1 Charging the Headphones

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge your JBL Tune 560BT headphones. The headphones are powered by a Lithium Polymer battery.

1. Connect the small end of the provided Micro-USB charging cable to the Micro-USB port on the right earcup of your headphones.
2. Connect the larger end of the charging cable to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
3. The LED indicator will illuminate during charging and turn off once charging is complete. A full charge typically takes approximately 2 hours, providing up to 16 hours of playback.

4.2 Bluetooth Pairing

To connect your headphones to a Bluetooth-enabled device (smartphone, tablet, laptop):

1. Ensure the headphones are turned off.
2. Press and hold the Power button for approximately 3-5 seconds until the LED indicator flashes blue rapidly. This indicates the headphones are in pairing mode.
3. On your device, go to the Bluetooth settings and enable Bluetooth.
4. Search for available devices. You should see "JBL TUNE560BT" in the list.
5. Select "JBL TUNE560BT" to connect. Once connected, the LED indicator will turn solid blue or flash slowly.
6. If prompted for a passcode, enter "0000".

The headphones will automatically reconnect to the last paired device when turned on, if the device's Bluetooth is active and within range.

5. Operating

5.1 Power On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button for 2 seconds. The LED indicator will light up.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button for 2 seconds. The LED indicator will turn off.

5.2 Music Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Press the Multi-function button once.

- **Volume Up:** Press the Volume + button.
- **Volume Down:** Press the Volume - button.
- **Next Track:** Double-press the Multi-function button.
- **Previous Track:** Triple-press the Multi-function button.

5.3 Call Management

- **Answer/End Call:** Press the Multi-function button once.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Multi-function button for 2 seconds.
- **Switch Between Calls:** During a call, press the Multi-function button once to switch to an incoming call and put the current call on hold.

5.4 Voice Assistant

Activate your device's voice assistant (e.g., Siri, Google Assistant) by pressing and holding the Multi-function button for 2 seconds when not on a call.

6. Maintenance

6.1 Cleaning

To maintain the appearance and functionality of your headphones:

- Wipe the earcups and headband with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or chemical solvents, as these may damage the surface.
- Avoid getting moisture into any openings. The headphones are water resistant, but not waterproof.

6.2 Storage

When not in use, store your headphones in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Utilize the foldable design to minimize space.

7. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your JBL Tune 560BT headphones, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headphones fully.
Cannot pair with device.	Headphones not in pairing mode; Bluetooth off on device; device too far.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (rapid blue flash); enable Bluetooth on your device; move device closer to headphones (within 10m/33ft).
No sound or low volume.	Volume too low; headphones not connected; incorrect audio output selected.	Increase volume on headphones and device; ensure headphones are properly paired; check audio output settings on your device.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Poor sound quality.	Interference; device too far; low battery.	Move away from sources of interference (Wi-Fi routers, other Bluetooth devices); move device closer; charge headphones.
Microphone not working.	Microphone muted on device; incorrect input selected.	Check microphone settings on your device; ensure headphones are selected as the audio input.
