Intex 68605 Manual Foot Pump Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Intex 68605 Manual Foot Pump. This pump is designed for efficient inflation and deflation of various inflatable items such as air mattresses, inflatable boats, and pool toys. It features a double-speed mechanism for high airflow with both up and down movements, and comes with multiple nozzle sizes to ensure compatibility with most valves.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Read all instructions carefully** before using the pump.
- **Do not use this pump to inflate high-pressure items** such as tires or compressed air tanks. This pump is designed for low-pressure, high-volume inflatables.
- **Keep out of reach of children.** This is not a toy.
- **Do not leave the pump unattended** during operation.
- **Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight or extreme temperatures** to prevent damage to the pump material.
- **Ensure the hose and nozzles are securely attached** before operating to prevent air leakage or detachment.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present:

- 1 x Intex 68605 Manual Foot Pump
- 1 x Flexible Hose

- 3 x Interconnecting Nozzles (various sizes)

SETUP

1. **Unpack the pump:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Attach the hose:** Connect the flexible hose to the designated port on the pump. Ensure it is firmly secured.
3. **Select the correct nozzle:** The pump includes three different nozzle sizes. Choose the nozzle that best fits

the valve of the item you intend to inflate or deflate. Attach the selected nozzle to the end of the flexible hose.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Inflation

1. **Connect to item:** Insert the chosen nozzle securely into the inflation valve of your inflatable item.
2. **Position the pump:** Place the foot pump on a flat, stable surface.
3. **Begin pumping:** Place your foot on the pump's base and use your hands to press the handle down and pull it up. The double-speed mechanism allows air to be pumped on both the up and down strokes, providing efficient inflation.
4. **Monitor inflation:** Continue pumping until the item is firm to the touch, but do not overinflate. Refer to the inflatable item's instructions for recommended inflation levels.
5. **Remove nozzle:** Once inflated, quickly remove the nozzle and close the item's valve.

Deflation

The Intex 68605 foot pump can also be used to deflate items, which helps in compact storage.

1. **Connect to deflation port:** Connect the flexible hose to the deflation port on the pump (usually marked or indicated in the pump's design).
2. **Connect to item:** Insert the appropriate nozzle securely into the deflation valve of your inflatable item.
3. **Begin pumping:** Operate the pump by pressing the handle down and pulling it up. This action will draw air out of the inflatable item.
4. **Continue until flat:** Continue pumping until the item is fully deflated and can be easily folded or stored.
5. **Remove nozzle:** Once deflated, remove the nozzle and close the item's valve.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the pump clean with a damp cloth after use. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the pump in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure the hose is not kinked during storage.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the hose and nozzles for any signs of wear, cracks, or damage. Replace if necessary.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Low airflow:** Ensure the hose is securely attached to both the pump and the nozzle. Check that the nozzle is correctly inserted into the inflatable item's valve.

- **Pump not moving smoothly:** Check for any obstructions in the pump mechanism. Ensure the pump is on a flat surface.
- **Item not inflating/deflating:** Verify that you are using the correct port for inflation or deflation. Ensure the valve on the inflatable item is open and the nozzle creates a tight seal.
