## 1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the CANDY CI642CTT Induction Hob. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your new appliance. Please read it thoroughly before installation and operation, and keep it for future reference.

## 1.1 Safety Instructions

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, burns, or injury.

- Ensure the appliance is installed by a qualified technician in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not operate the hob if the ceramic glass surface is cracked or broken. Contact customer service immediately.
- Keep children away from the appliance during operation as surfaces can become hot.
- Do not store flammable materials on or near the hob.
- · Use only induction-compatible cookware.
- Never leave cooking unattended, especially when using high heat settings.
- Clean the hob regularly to prevent grease buildup, which can be a fire hazard.
- Disconnect the appliance from the power supply before cleaning or maintenance.

## 2. Product Overview

#### 2.1 Components

The CANDY CI642CTT Induction Hob features four independent cooking zones and a sleek ceramic glass surface.

## 2.2 Control Panel

The touch-sensitive control panel allows for precise management of each cooking zone and access to special functions.

## 3. Installation

Proper installation is crucial for the safe and optimal performance of your induction hob. It must be installed by a qualified electrician or technician.

## 3.1 Placement and Dimensions

Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance. Refer to the diagram below for precise cutout dimensions for your countertop.




Figure 3.1: Installation diagram showing the required cutout dimensions for the countertop and the hob's overall size.

## 3.2 Electrical Connection

The hob requires a dedicated electrical circuit. Ensure the power supply matches the specifications on the rating plate of the appliance. The connection must be made using an electric cable by a qualified professional.

- Verify that the voltage and frequency of your electrical supply match those indicated on the hob's rating label.
- Install an all-pole disconnection switch with a contact separation of at least 3mm in the fixed wiring.
- The appliance must be earthed.

# 4. Operation

#### 4.1 First Use

Before first use, clean the ceramic glass surface with a damp cloth. Ensure all packaging materials are removed. The hob may emit a slight odor during its first few uses; this is normal and will dissipate.

## 4.2 Basic Cooking

- 1. Place suitable induction-compatible cookware centrally on the desired cooking zone.
- 2. Touch the power button to turn on the hob.
- 3. Select the cooking zone you wish to activate.

- 4. Adjust the heat level using the '+' and '-' touch controls. The display will show the selected power level.
- 5. To turn off a cooking zone, select it and reduce the power level to '0' or press the dedicated off button if available.
- 6. To turn off the entire hob, touch the main power button.

## 4.3 Special Functions

The CANDY CI642CTT Induction Hob is equipped with advanced features to enhance your cooking experience.

- **Boost Function:** This function temporarily increases the power of a selected cooking zone to its maximum level, ideal for rapidly boiling water or searing food. Activate by selecting the zone and pressing the 'Boost' button (if available) or by quickly increasing the power to the highest setting. The booster will automatically reduce power after a set time to prevent overheating.
- Stop-&-Go Function: This feature allows you to pause all active cooking zones and then resume them with the same settings. This is useful if you need to step away from the hob temporarily. Press the 'Stop-&-Go' button to activate and deactivate.
- **Timer Function:** Each cooking zone can be set with an independent timer. Once the set time expires, the cooking zone will automatically switch off.

## 5. Cleaning and Maintenance

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your induction hob.

## **5.1 Daily Cleaning**

- · Always ensure the hob is cool before cleaning.
- Wipe the ceramic glass surface with a soft cloth or sponge and warm soapy water.
- For stubborn stains, use a specialized ceramic hob cleaner.
- Rinse thoroughly and dry with a clean cloth to prevent water marks.

#### 5.2 Deep Cleaning

- For burnt-on food or melted plastic, use a hob scraper designed for ceramic glass surfaces. Hold the scraper at a shallow angle to avoid scratching.
- Apply a small amount of ceramic hob cleaner and rub gently with a paper towel.
- Polish the surface with a clean, dry cloth for a streak-free finish.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or harsh chemicals as they can damage the surface.

# 6. Troubleshooting

Before contacting customer service, please refer to the following table for common issues and their solutions.

**Table 6.1: Common Troubleshooting Guide** 

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Hob does not turn on.	No power supply; child lock activated.	Check circuit breaker; deactivate child lock (refer to control panel section).

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cooking zone not heating.	Cookware not induction-compatible or not properly placed.	Use induction-compatible cookware; ensure cookware is centered on the zone.
Display shows an error code.	Specific internal error.	Turn off the hob, wait a few minutes, then turn it back on. If the error persists, contact customer service.
Hob makes a buzzing noise.	Normal operation of induction technology; cookware quality.	This is normal. Some cookware may amplify the sound. Ensure cookware has a flat, thick base.
Hob turns off unexpectedly.	Overheating protection activated; spill on control panel.	Allow hob to cool down; clean control panel and ensure it's dry.
