1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper use, fitting, and maintenance of your T'nB Urban Moov Protective Helmet. Designed for activities such as scootering, cycling, and skateboarding, this helmet offers protection against impacts and bumps. Please read these instructions carefully before use to ensure maximum safety and product longevity.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety is paramount. This helmet is designed to reduce the risk of head injury during falls or impacts. It complies with safety standards EN 1078:2012 + A1:2012.

- Always wear your helmet correctly fitted and securely fastened.
- A helmet cannot protect against all possible injuries.
- Inspect the helmet for any damage before each use. Do not use a damaged helmet.
- After a significant impact, even if no visible damage is apparent, the helmet should be replaced. Its protective capacity may be compromised.
- Avoid exposing the helmet to extreme temperatures or corrosive substances, as this may degrade its materials.

3. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

The T'nB Urban Moov Protective Helmet package includes:

- 1 x T'nB Urban Moov Protective Helmet (Size L)
- 1 x Instruction Manual

4. FITTING AND ADJUSTMENT

Proper fit is crucial for the helmet's effectiveness. Follow these steps to ensure a secure and comfortable fit:

1. **Placement:** Place the helmet squarely on your head, ensuring it covers your forehead. The front edge should be approximately two finger-widths above your eyebrows.
2. **Rear Adjustment System:** The helmet features a rear adjustment system. Turn the dial located at the back of the helmet clockwise to tighten and counter-clockwise to loosen. Adjust until the helmet feels snug and does not move freely when you shake your head.
3. **Chin Strap Adjustment:** Fasten the chin strap buckle. Adjust the strap tension so that it is snug under your chin, but not uncomfortably tight. You should be able to fit one or two fingers between the strap and your chin.
4. **Side Straps:** Adjust the side straps so that they form a 'V' shape just below your ears. Ensure the straps do not cover your ears.
5. **Final Check:** Once adjusted, try to move the helmet from side to side and front to back. It should not shift significantly. Open your mouth wide; the helmet should press down slightly on your head. If it does not, tighten the chin strap.

5. USAGE GUIDELINES

This helmet is intended for use during recreational activities such as:

- Cycling
- Scootering
- Skateboarding
- Inline Skating

Always ensure the helmet is properly fitted and secured before engaging in any activity. The 11 air vents provide improved ventilation to prevent excessive perspiration during use.

6. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

To maintain your helmet's condition and protective capabilities:

- **Cleaning:** Clean the helmet with a soft cloth, mild soap, and water only. Avoid harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the helmet's materials and compromise its integrity.
- **Storage:** Store the helmet in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Do not store it near heat sources.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the helmet for any signs of wear, cracks, dents, or strap damage. If any damage is found, replace the helmet immediately.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your helmet, consider the following:

- **Helmet feels loose:** Re-adjust the rear adjustment system and chin strap as described in Section 4. Ensure all straps are snug.
- **Helmet is uncomfortable:** Check if the helmet is positioned correctly on your head. Ensure no straps are twisted or pinching. Adjust the fit gradually until comfortable.
- **Excessive perspiration:** The helmet features 11 air vents for ventilation. Ensure your activity level is appropriate for the conditions.

If problems persist or you suspect the helmet's integrity is compromised, discontinue use and contact customer support.
