PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Hunter Trimaran 52-inch Ceiling Fan (Model 59609) in Matte Black Finish is designed for both indoor and outdoor spaces, offering efficient air circulation and modern aesthetics. SAFETY INFORMATION

Before beginning installation, read all instructions carefully. Improper installation can lead to electric shock, fire, or personal injury. Always consult a qualified electrician if you are unsure about any part of the installation process.

- Ensure the power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation or maintenance.
- All wiring must be in accordance with national and local electrical codes.
- The mounting structure must be capable of supporting the fan's weight (approximately 18.7 lbs / 8.5 kg).
- Do not bend the blade brackets when installing the blades, balancing the blades, or cleaning the fan.
- Keep hands, feet, and other objects clear of the rotating fan blades.

COMPONENTS LIST

Verify that all components are present before beginning installation. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact Hunter Fan Company customer service.

Included Components

Component	Quantity	Description
Fan Motor Assembly	1	Main body of the ceiling fan.
Fan Blades	3	Matte black blades for air movement.
Wall Control	1	For adjusting fan speed.
Downrods	2	One 4-inch and one 2-inch downrod for mounting.
Hardware Pack	1	Screws, washers, and other small parts for assembly.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION




Image: Cover of the Hunter Trimaran Installation Manual, indicating detailed setup instructions are available separately.

Mounting Options:

The Hunter Trimaran fan offers flexible mounting to suit various ceiling configurations:

- Standard Mounting: Uses the included 4-inch downrod for typical ceiling heights.
- Low Profile Mounting: Uses the included 2-inch downrod for lower ceiling heights.
- Angled Mounting: Requires a separate angled mounting kit (not included) for sloped ceilings.




Image: Diagram illustrating fan dimensions (A and B) for low profile, standard, and angled mounting configurations, showing how the overall height changes with different downrods.

Wiring and Wall Control Installation:

Connect the fan's wiring to your household electrical system according to the provided wiring diagrams in the installation manual. The included wall control unit should be installed in place of a standard wall switch. Ensure all connections are secure and insulated.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Wall Control:

The included wall control allows you to easily adjust the fan's speed. Rotate the dial to increase or decrease the fan's rotation speed. If your fan model includes a light kit (this model does not), the wall control would also manage light functions.

Reversible Motor Function:

The fan features a reversible motor for year-round comfort. A switch on the fan's motor housing controls the direction of blade rotation. To change the direction:

- 1. Ensure the fan is completely off and the blades have stopped rotating.
- 2. Locate the reverse switch on the motor housing (often a small slide switch).

- 3. Slide the switch to the opposite position.
- 4. Turn the fan back on.

For summer operation, the blades should rotate counter-clockwise (downdraft) to create a cooling breeze. For winter operation, the blades should rotate clockwise (updraft) to circulate warm air trapped near the ceiling.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your Hunter Trimaran ceiling fan.

Cleaning:

- · Always turn off the power at the circuit breaker before cleaning.
- Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the fan blades and motor housing. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents, as they may damage the finish.
- For outdoor installations, periodically wipe down the fan to remove dirt, dust, and salt residue to maintain the WeatherMax finish.

Blade Care:

The fan blades are designed to be droop-free and durable. Avoid bending the blades or applying excessive force during cleaning or handling.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If your Hunter Trimaran ceiling fan is not operating correctly, consult the following common issues and solutions. For more complex problems, contact customer support.

Common Troubleshooting Guide

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not start	No power to the fan; Loose wire connections; Blown fuse/tripped circuit breaker.	Check circuit breaker and wall switch; Ensure all wiring connections are secure; Replace fuse or reset breaker.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan wobbles excessively	Loose blade screws; Unbalanced blades; Improper mounting.	Tighten all blade screws; Use a balancing kit (not included) if necessary; Recheck mounting bracket and downrod connections.
Noisy operation	Loose screws; Motor housing rubbing; Bearings need lubrication.	Check and tighten all screws; Ensure no parts are rubbing; Contact customer support if motor noise persists.
