# Milly Mally 2-in-1 Wooden Balance Bike

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Milly Mally 2-in-1 Wooden Balance Bike. This versatile bike is designed to assist toddlers aged 18-36 months in developing balance and coordination, transitioning from a stable tricycle to a two-wheeled balance bike as their skills progress. Please read these instructions carefully before use and retain them for future reference.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Age Range:** Suitable for children aged 18 to 36 months.
- **Maximum Load:** The bike is designed to support a maximum weight of 25 kg (55 lbs). Do not exceed this limit.
- **Adult Supervision:** Always ensure children are supervised by an adult while using the balance bike.
- **Protective Gear:** Always wear appropriate protective gear, including a helmet, knee pads, and elbow pads, when riding.
- **Riding Environment:** Use the bike on flat, even surfaces, away from traffic, stairs, steep inclines, or water bodies.
- **Handlebar Limiter:** The bike features a handlebar turning limiter to prevent excessive steering, enhancing stability for young riders. Ensure this mechanism is functioning correctly.
- **Safety Standards:** This product conforms to European safety standards.
- **Pre-Ride Check:** Before each use, check that all bolts, nuts, and components are securely fastened and that the wheels rotate freely.

## PRODUCT COMPONENTS

The Milly Mally 2-in-1 Balance Bike typically includes the following main components:

- Wooden Frame
- Handlebars with non-slip grips
- Adjustable Seat

- Foam Wheels (2 or 3, depending on configuration)
- Assembly Hardware (bolts, nuts, washers)

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Milly Mally 2-in-1 Balance Bike can be configured as a three-wheeled tricycle for initial stability or a two-wheeled balance bike for advanced balance training. Assembly is required.

### 1. Initial Assembly (Tricycle Mode)

1. Carefully unpack all components and verify against the parts list (not provided in this document, refer to packaging).
2. Attach the front fork and handlebar assembly to the main frame. Secure with provided hardware.
3. Attach the two rear wheels to the rear axle, ensuring they are securely fastened.
4. Attach the seat to the frame.

### 2. Converting to Two-Wheeled Balance Bike Mode

To convert from a tricycle to a two-wheeled balance bike, remove one of the rear wheels and adjust the remaining wheel to the center position, if applicable, or follow specific instructions provided with your product for this conversion. This typically involves reconfiguring the rear axle to hold a single wheel.

### 3. Adjusting Seat Height

The seat height is adjustable to accommodate your child's growth. There are typically 4 levels of adjustment. To adjust, loosen the seat fastening mechanism, slide the seat to the desired height, and securely tighten it. Ensure your child's feet can comfortably touch the ground with a slight bend in their knees when seated.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Riding the Balance Bike

The balance bike is designed for children to propel themselves forward by pushing off the ground with their feet. This method helps them develop balance, coordination, and leg strength without the need for pedals or training wheels.

- Ensure the child is wearing appropriate safety gear.
- Adjust the seat height so the child's feet are flat on the ground with knees slightly bent.
- Encourage the child to walk or run while seated, gradually lifting their feet off the ground to glide.
- The handlebar limiter helps prevent over-steering, providing a safer learning experience.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the wooden frame with a damp cloth and mild soap if necessary. Avoid harsh chemicals or excessive water, which can damage the wood. Dry thoroughly.
- **Inspections:** Regularly check all bolts, nuts, and screws to ensure they are tight. Inspect the wheels and foam tires for any signs of wear or damage.
- **Storage:** Store the balance bike in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures, to preserve the wood and other materials.
- **Lubrication:** The foam wheels and bearings are designed for low maintenance. No lubrication is typically required.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Instability:** Ensure all wheels are securely attached and the seat height is correctly adjusted for the child. Check for any loose components.
- **Difficulty Steering:** Verify that the handlebar assembly is correctly installed and not overly tightened, allowing for smooth movement within the limiter's range.
- **Unusual Noises:** Inspect all moving parts for obstructions or loose fittings. Tighten any loose bolts or screws.
