1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your Powermatic III+ Electric Cigarette Injector Machine. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device and retain it for future reference.

Important Safety Information

- Ensure the machine is placed on a stable, level surface during operation.
- Keep hands and foreign objects away from moving parts during operation.
- Do not operate the machine with wet hands or near water.
- Use only dry, shredded tobacco specifically designed for cigarette injection machines. Moist or overly coarse tobacco can cause jams and damage the machine.
- Unplug the machine from the power outlet before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

3. SETUP

1. **Unpack the Machine:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Placement:** Place the Powermatic III+ machine on a clean, stable, and dry surface. Ensure there is enough space around the machine for operation and tobacco handling.
3. **Connect Power:** Insert the power cord into the machine's power port and then plug the other end into a standard electrical outlet. The digital display should illuminate.
4. **Prepare Tobacco:** Ensure your tobacco is properly shredded and dry. Remove any stems or large pieces that could cause a jam.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to operate your Powermatic III+ Electric Cigarette Injector Machine:

1. **Load Tobacco:** Open the tobacco hopper lid and fill the hopper with your prepared tobacco. Do not overfill or pack the tobacco too tightly in the hopper. The machine is designed to hold enough tobacco for approximately 32 king-sized cigarettes.
2. **Place Cigarette Tube:** Carefully slide an empty cigarette tube onto the nozzle located on the side of the machine. Ensure the tube is fully seated.
3. **Start Injection:** Press the **START** button. The machine will automatically inject the tobacco into the tube.
4. **Remove Cigarette:** Once the injection process is complete, gently remove the filled cigarette from the nozzle.

5. **Repeat:** Continue steps 2-4 until you have produced the desired number of cigarettes. The machine's digital display will track the number of cigarettes made.

Automatic Jam Protection

The Powermatic III+ features an automatic jam protection system. If a tobacco jam is detected, the machine will stop operation to prevent damage. Refer to the Troubleshooting section for instructions on how to clear a jam.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure optimal performance and longevity of your machine.

- **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, unplug the machine. Use the provided brush to remove any loose tobacco from the hopper, nozzle, and surrounding areas.
- **Clearing Residue:** Periodically, use the poker tool to gently clear any tobacco residue from the injection mechanism and nozzle. Be careful not to force the tool or damage internal components.
- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the machine with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the machine in water.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the machine in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Powermatic III+ machine.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Machine does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet issue; faulty power cord.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged into both the machine and a working electrical outlet. Test the outlet with another device. If issues persist, contact support.
Tobacco does not inject or machine jams.	Tobacco is too moist, too coarse, or packed too tightly; foreign object in mechanism; worn parts.	Unplug the machine. Remove all tobacco from the hopper. Use cleaning tools to clear any obstructions from the nozzle and injection area. Ensure tobacco is dry and properly shredded. Do not overfill the hopper.
Cigarettes are too loose or too tight.	Tobacco consistency; amount of tobacco loaded.	Adjust the amount of tobacco loaded into the hopper. Experiment with different tobacco types and moisture levels to find the optimal consistency for your preference.
Machine makes unusual noises.	Internal obstruction; mechanical issue.	Unplug the machine and inspect for any visible obstructions. If the noise persists or indicates a malfunction, discontinue use and contact customer support.


