SETUP

1. Unpacking

5. Confirm the enrollment.

2. Clocking In/Out

To clock in or out, users simply place their registered finger on the fingerprint sensor. The device will confirm the successful scan with a visual and/or audible prompt. The time record will be automatically saved.

3. Data Management

The NE-230 allows for data retrieval and management. Consult the device's on-screen menu for options to download attendance records, generate reports, or clear data. This typically involves connecting a USB drive or using network connectivity if available.

MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not power on.	No power, faulty adapter, or power outlet issue.	Check power cable connection. Ensure the power adapter is functioning. Try a different power outlet.
Fingerprint not recognized.	Fingerprint not properly enrolled, dirty sensor, or wet/damaged finger.	Ensure your finger is clean and dry. Clean the fingerprint sensor. Try re-enrolling your fingerprint. Ensure the finger is placed correctly on the sensor.
Incorrect time/date displayed.	Time/date settings are incorrect.	Access the administrator menu and adjust the date and time settings.
Cannot access administrator menu.	Incorrect administrator fingerprint/password or no administrator set up.	Ensure you are using the correct administrator credentials. If forgotten, refer to the device's reset procedure (if available) or contact support.
