INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your ONN ONA18CH901 HD Outdoor Antenna. This antenna offers a 150-mile range, 360-degree motorized rotation, and supports 1080P and 4K transmission for high-quality viewing. It is designed for durability and includes pre-assembled mounting hardware for various placement options, making it suitable for rural or suburban areas.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Please ensure all components are present before beginning installation:

- ONN ONA18CH901 HD Outdoor Antenna Unit
- Mounting Pole (extends from 20 51 inches)
- Motorized Rotator
- Control Box
- Remote Control
- Power Adapter for Control Box
- · Coaxial Cable
- Mounting Hardware and Cable Clips

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation is crucial for optimal performance. Follow these steps carefully:

1. Antenna Assembly

Assemble the main antenna unit according to the diagrams provided in the included manual. Ensure all elements are securely fastened. The antenna features a pre-assembled design for ease of setup.

2. Mounting the Antenna

Choose a suitable outdoor location for mounting, such as a wall, roof, or balcony. The included mounting pole extends from 20 to 51 inches. Securely attach the antenna unit to the mounting pole using the provided hardware. Ensure the pole is stable and the antenna has a clear line of sight to broadcast towers if possible.

3. Connecting the Coaxial Cable

Connect one end of the coaxial cable to the antenna unit. Run the cable to the indoor control box, securing it along the path with cable clips to prevent damage.

4. Control Box Setup

Connect the other end of the coaxial cable from the antenna to the 'ANT IN' port on the control box. Plug the power adapter into the control box and then into a power outlet. Connect a separate coaxial cable from the 'TV OUT' port on the control box to the 'ANT IN' or 'CABLE IN' port on your television.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Channel Scan

Turn on your television and navigate to the TV's menu. Select 'Antenna' or 'Air' as the input source. Perform a channel scan or auto-tune function. This will allow your TV to detect and save all available over-the-air channels.

2. Motorized Rotation

Use the included remote control to rotate the antenna 360 degrees. This allows you to fine-tune the antenna's direction to achieve the best possible signal reception for various channels. Experiment with different orientations to maximize your channel count and signal quality.

MAINTENANCE

- **Periodic Checks:** Regularly inspect the antenna, mounting pole, and coaxial cable for any signs of wear, damage, or loose connections.
- Cleaning: Keep the antenna free from dirt, debris, and ice buildup. Use a soft cloth and mild detergent if necessary.
- **Weather Protection:** The antenna is designed to be lightning protected and weather-resistant. However, in severe weather conditions, consider additional precautions if possible.

Troubleshooting

• No Signal/Poor Reception:

- Ensure all cable connections are secure.
- Re-scan for channels on your TV.
- Adjust the antenna's direction using the remote control.
- Check for any obstructions (trees, buildings) blocking the line of sight to broadcast towers.

Remote Control Not Working:

- Check the batteries in the remote control.
- Ensure the control box is powered on.

• Antenna Not Rotating:

- Verify the control box is receiving power.
- Check the connection between the antenna and the control box.
