## 1. INTRODUCTION

8. **Reassemble Vacuum:** Carefully reassemble the vacuum cleaner casing, ensuring all covers are properly aligned and all screws are tightened. Do not force any parts.
9. **Test Functionality:** Plug the vacuum cleaner back into the power outlet and perform a brief test to ensure the motor unit operates correctly and the vacuum functions as expected. Listen for unusual noises.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

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Once the TOP VACUUM PARTS replacement motor unit is correctly installed, it functions as an integral part of your Electrolux vacuum cleaner. There are no separate operating instructions for the motor unit itself. Please refer to your vacuum cleaner's original instruction manual for detailed operating procedures, including power settings, attachment usage, and general cleaning guidelines.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

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The motor unit itself is a sealed component and generally requires no user-level maintenance. However, to ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your vacuum cleaner and the new motor unit, consider the following:

- **Keep Air Vents Clear:** Ensure that the vacuum cleaner's air intake and exhaust vents are free from dust and debris to allow for proper airflow and prevent motor overheating.
- **Regular Filter Replacement:** Regularly clean or replace your vacuum's filters as recommended by the original manufacturer. Clogged filters can strain the motor.
- **Check for Obstructions:** Periodically check hoses, attachments, and the brush roll for any blockages that could impede airflow and put stress on the motor.
- **Avoid Liquid Exposure:** Do not use the vacuum to pick up liquids, as this can severely damage the motor unit and other electrical components.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

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If you encounter issues after installing the replacement motor unit, consider the following troubleshooting steps:

- **Vacuum Does Not Turn On:**
  - Ensure the vacuum is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
