# Frigidaire Retro Compact Fridge User Manual

Model: EFR376-CORAL

## 1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions before operating your new Frigidaire Retro Compact Fridge. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Electrical Safety:** Ensure the refrigerator is plugged into a grounded 3-prong outlet. Do not remove the grounding prong. Do not use an adapter.
- **Ventilation:** Allow adequate space around the refrigerator for proper ventilation (at least 5 inches on sides and back, 10 inches on top). Blocking vents can cause overheating and reduced efficiency.
- **Placement:** Place the refrigerator on a flat, stable surface away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and moisture.
- **Flammable Materials:** Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with flammable propellants in this appliance.
- **Children Safety:** Supervise children when they are near the appliance. Never allow children to play with or inside the refrigerator.
- **Defrosting:** Do not use mechanical devices or other means to accelerate the defrosting process, other than those recommended by the manufacturer.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Frigidaire Retro Compact Fridge (Model EFR376-CORAL) is a 3.2 cubic foot countertop refrigerator designed for convenience and style. It features a built-in bottle opener, a chiller compartment, and adjustable storage options.

### Key Features:

- **Capacity:** 3.2 cubic feet of storage.
- **Chiller Compartment:** Includes an interior freezer section with an ice cube tray.
- **Storage:** Two adjustable glass shelves, a 2-liter door basket, and a built-in can dispenser.
- **Design:** Retro aesthetic with a flush back design and reversible door.

- **Convenience:** Built-in bottle opener and adjustable leveling legs.

## 3. SETUP

### 3.1 Unpacking

1. Carefully remove all packaging materials, including the base and any tape.
2. Inspect the refrigerator for any shipping damage. If damage is found, contact your retailer immediately.
3. Remove all internal packing materials, including shelves and accessories.

### 3.2 Placement

- Choose a location with a strong, level floor capable of supporting the refrigerator when fully loaded.
- Ensure there is at least 5 inches of space on the sides and back, and 10 inches on top for proper air circulation.

- Avoid placing the unit near heat sources (stoves, heaters) or in direct sunlight.
- For optimal performance, allow the refrigerator to stand upright and unplugged for at least 24 hours before plugging it in. This allows the refrigerant to settle.

### 3.3 Leveling

The refrigerator has adjustable leveling legs at the front. Turn the legs clockwise to raise the unit or counter-clockwise to lower it. Ensure the refrigerator is level to prevent vibrations and ensure proper door sealing.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 4.1 Temperature Control

The temperature control dial is located inside the refrigerator compartment. Turn the dial to adjust the cooling intensity. Higher numbers indicate colder temperatures. Start with a medium setting and adjust as needed.

### 4.2 Chiller Compartment

The chiller compartment is designed for short-term storage of frozen items and for making ice. An ice cube tray is included. Do not use this compartment for long-term freezing of food.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### 5.1 Cleaning

- Always unplug the refrigerator before cleaning.
- Clean the interior and exterior surfaces with a soft cloth and mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- Wipe down door gaskets regularly to ensure a tight seal.
- Clean the condenser coils at the back of the unit periodically (every 6-12 months) to maintain efficiency.

## 5.2 Defrosting

This unit features automatic defrost for the main refrigerator compartment. The chiller compartment may accumulate frost and require manual defrosting. To defrost the chiller compartment:

1. Remove all items from the chiller compartment.
2. Unplug the refrigerator.
3. Leave the chiller compartment door open to allow frost to melt naturally. Place a towel at the bottom to catch water.
4. Once defrosted, wipe dry and plug the unit back in.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your refrigerator, consult the following table before contacting service.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Refrigerator does not operate	Not plugged in; circuit breaker tripped; temperature control set to OFF.	Check power connection; reset circuit breaker; adjust temperature control.
Temperature is too warm	Door opened too frequently; warm food placed inside; poor ventilation; temperature control set too high.	Minimize door openings; allow hot food to cool before storing; ensure proper clearance; adjust temperature control to a colder setting.
Excessive noise	Refrigerator is not level; unit touching a wall; items inside rattling.	Adjust leveling legs; move unit away from walls; rearrange items inside.
Water on floor	Drain tube clogged; manual defrost water overflow.	Clear drain tube; ensure proper towel placement during manual defrost.
