1. Product Overview

The Frigidaire Retro Compact Refrigerator EFR376-MOONBM is a 3.2 cubic foot appliance designed for compact spaces such as offices, bedrooms, dorm rooms, or cabins. It features a retro design with modern conveniences, including a chiller compartment and a built-in bottle opener. 2. Safety Information

Before operating this appliance, read all instructions carefully to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Electrical Safety:** Ensure the refrigerator is plugged into a grounded outlet. Do not use extension cords.
- **Flammable Refrigerant:** This appliance uses flammable refrigerant (R600a). It must be repaired only by trained service personnel. Do not puncture refrigerant tubing.
- **Ventilation:** Allow adequate space around the refrigerator for proper ventilation.
- **Cleaning:** Unplug the appliance before cleaning.

3. Setup & Installation

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all packaging materials, including tape and protective films. Inspect the refrigerator for any damage during transit. Keep packaging materials away from children.

3.2 Placement

Place the refrigerator on a flat, stable surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources. The space-saving flush back design allows for seamless placement against walls. Ensure adequate clearance for the door to open fully.

3.3 Leveling

The refrigerator is equipped with adjustable leveling legs. Adjust these legs to ensure the unit is stable and level. Proper leveling helps in efficient operation and door alignment.

3.4 Reversible Door

The door is reversible, allowing for flexible placement options. Consult the detailed instructions in the full product manual for steps on how to reverse the door swing.

3.5 Bottle Opener Installation

The built-in bottle opener is typically installed on the side of the unit. Secure it using the provided screws. Ensure it is firmly attached before use.

3.6 Initial Power-On

After placement and installation, plug the refrigerator into a dedicated grounded electrical outlet. Allow the unit to stand upright for at least 2-4 hours before plugging it in to allow the refrigerant to settle. Allow the refrigerator to cool for several hours before placing items inside.

4. Operating Instructions

4.1 Temperature Control

The refrigerator features an adjustable thermostat to control the internal temperature. Locate the thermostat dial inside the unit, typically near the chiller compartment. Turn the dial to your desired setting. Higher numbers generally indicate colder temperatures.

4.2 Internal Organization

The 3.2 cu. ft. capacity provides ample storage. Utilize the two glass shelves for various items. The door includes a 2-liter bottle basket and a built-in can dispenser for organized beverage storage.

4.3 Chiller Compartment

The mini fridge includes a chiller compartment, ideal for keeping ice or frozen treats. An ice cube tray is typically included. This compartment is not a full freezer but provides colder temperatures than the main refrigerator section.

4.4 Quiet Operation

This model is designed for quiet operation, making it suitable for environments like bedrooms, offices, or dorm

rooms where noise levels are a concern.

5. Maintenance

5.1 Cleaning

Regularly clean the interior and exterior of your refrigerator. Use a soft cloth with a mild detergent and warm water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals. Ensure the unit is unplugged before cleaning.

5.2 Defrosting

This refrigerator features manual defrost. Over time, frost may build up in the chiller compartment. To defrost, unplug the unit, remove all contents, and allow the frost to melt naturally. Place towels to absorb water. Once defrosted, clean and dry the interior before plugging it back in.

6. Troubleshooting

If you experience issues with your Frigidaire Retro Compact Refrigerator, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Refrigerator Not Cooling:** Check if the power cord is securely plugged in. Ensure the thermostat is set to an appropriate temperature. Verify that the door is closing completely and the seal is intact.
- **Unusual Noise:** Ensure the refrigerator is level. Check for any items inside or on top of the unit that might be vibrating. Normal operating sounds include compressor hum and refrigerant flow.
- **Excessive Frost Build-up:** This indicates a need for manual defrosting. Ensure the door is not left open for extended periods.

For more complex issues, consult a qualified service technician.




Image 7.1: Key dimensions of the refrigerator.
