- Use only with a Philips Hue Bridge for full smart functionality.
- Ensure the mounting surface can support the weight of the fixture.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Step 1: Electrical Installation

- 1. **Power Disconnection:** Turn off power at the main circuit breaker to the area where the lantern will be installed.
- 2. **Mounting Bracket:** Secure the mounting bracket to the wall using the provided hardware. Ensure it is level and firmly attached.
- 3. **Wiring:** Connect the fixture's wires to the household electrical wires (live, neutral, ground) using the provided wire nuts. Match colors (typically black to black, white to white, green/bare copper to ground). Ensure all connections are secure.

- **Google Assistant:** Link your Philips Hue account in the Google Home app. Use commands like "Hey Google, change the patio lights to blue."


