## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the vidaXL Garden Raised Bed. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new raised garden bed. Please read these instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain them for future reference.

This raised bed, measuring approximately 39.4 inches in length, 15.7 inches in width, and 30.3 inches in height, is designed to provide an optimal environment for growing various plants, vegetables, herbs, and flowers.

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

Assembly is required for this product. It is recommended that two people assist with the assembly process. Basic tools such as a drill and pliers may be helpful for securing fasteners.

### **Required Tools (Not Included):**

- Gloves (for hand protection)
- Screwdriver or drill with appropriate bit
- Pliers or wrench

### Assembly Steps:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Lay them out on a clean, flat surface. Verify all parts against the package contents list.
2. **Assemble Side Panels:** Connect the galvanized steel panels using the provided fasteners. Ensure the corrugated sides align correctly.




Image: Detail of the corner connection, showing how panels are joined with fasteners and corner brackets.

3. **Attach Corner Brackets:** Secure the corner brackets to the assembled panels using screws and nuts. Tighten all fasteners firmly but do not overtighten.
4. **Install Support Braces:** If your model includes internal support braces, attach them according to the diagrams to enhance stability.

5. **Final Placement:** Once assembled, carefully move the raised bed to its desired outdoor location. Ensure the surface is level and stable.

## OPERATING AND USAGE

---

The vidaXL Garden Raised Bed is designed for outdoor use and provides an elevated planting area, reducing the need for extensive bending during gardening tasks. Its open bottom design allows for direct root penetration into the ground, promoting healthier plant growth and natural drainage.

## Filling the Raised Bed:

1. **Layering:** Consider adding a layer of coarse material (e.g., branches, wood chips) at the bottom for drainage and to reduce the amount of soil needed.
2. **Soil:** Fill the raised bed with a high-quality soil mix suitable for your chosen plants. Ensure the soil level is a few inches below the top edge to prevent overflow during watering.
3. **Planting:** Plant your desired vegetables, herbs, or flowers, ensuring adequate spacing for growth.

## Benefits of a Raised Bed:

- Improved drainage and aeration for plant roots.
- Warmer soil temperatures in spring, allowing for earlier planting.
- Better control over soil quality and composition.
- Reduced weed growth compared to traditional ground beds.
- Easier access for planting, weeding, and harvesting.

## MAINTENANCE

---

The vidaXL Garden Raised Bed is constructed from heavy-duty galvanized steel, making it durable and weather-resistant. Minimal maintenance is required to ensure its longevity.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically wipe down the exterior surfaces with a damp cloth to remove dirt and debris. Avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the galvanized finish.
- **Inspection:** Annually inspect all fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten any loose screws or nuts.
- **Drainage:** Ensure the open bottom remains clear of obstructions to allow for proper drainage and root access.

- **Winter Care:** In regions with harsh winters, consider covering the raised bed or emptying it to prevent potential damage from freezing and thawing cycles, although the galvanized steel is designed for weather resistance.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem                                     | Possible Cause  | Solution   |

| Raised bed feels unstable after assembly.   | Loose fasteners or uneven ground.                                       | Check and tighten all screws and nuts. Ensure the raised bed is placed on a level surface.   |
| Difficulty aligning panels during assembly. | Panels are not correctly oriented or fasteners are partially tightened. | Ensure panels are oriented as per instructions. Loosen any partially tightened fasteners to allow for adjustment, then re-tighten. |
| Waterlogging in the raised bed.             | Poor soil drainage or obstructed open bottom.                           | Ensure the soil mix has good drainage. Check that the open bottom is not blocked by compacted soil or debris.                      |
| Missing parts upon delivery.                | Packaging error.  | Contact vidaXL customer support immediately with your purchase details.  |
