1. INTRODUCTION

The Mercusys MW300D Wireless Router is designed to provide a reliable and high-speed internet connection for your home or small office. This manual will guide you through the installation, configuration, and operation of your new router, ensuring you can maximize its performance and features.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always disconnect power before cleaning or servicing.
- Do not expose the device to water, fire, humidity, or hot environments.
- Do not attempt to disassemble, repair, or modify the device. If you need service, please contact technical support.
- Use only the power adapter provided with the device.
- Place the router in a well-ventilated area, away from direct sunlight and heat sources.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

4.1. Front Panel

The front panel of the MW300D features LED indicators that provide real-time status of the router's operation.

- **Power LED:** Indicates the power status.
- **DSL LED:** Indicates the DSL connection status.
- **Internet LED:** Indicates the internet connection status.
- **WLAN LED:** Indicates the wireless network status.

4.2. Rear Panel

The rear panel contains all the necessary ports for connecting your router to the internet and other devices.

- **Power Port:** Connects to the power adapter.
- **DSL Port:** Connects to your DSL line.
- **LAN Ports (x3):** Connects to your computers or other network devices.
- **Reset Button:** Used to restore the router to factory default settings.

5. SETUP

5.1. Hardware Connection

1. Connect the DSL cable from your wall DSL jack to the DSL port on the router.
2. Connect one end of the provided Ethernet cable to a LAN port on the router and the other end to the Ethernet port of your computer.
3. Connect the power adapter to the router's power port and plug the other end into a standard electrical outlet.
4. Wait for the Power, DSL, and Internet LEDs to become stable, indicating a successful connection.

5.2. Configure via Web Browser

1. Open a web browser (e.g., Chrome, Firefox, Edge) on the computer connected to the router.
2. Type the default access address (usually **mwlogin.net** or **192.168.1.1**) into the address bar and press Enter.
3. Create a login password when prompted.
4. Follow the on-screen Quick Setup Wizard to configure your internet connection and wireless settings. You will typically need your ISP-provided DSL username and password.

6. OPERATING

6.1. Wireless Network Configuration

To change your Wi-Fi network name (SSID) or password:

1. Log in to the router's web management page.
2. Navigate to the 'Wireless' or 'Wi-Fi' settings.
3. Modify the SSID and Wireless Password fields.
4. Save your changes. Your devices will need to reconnect using the new password.

6.2. Internet Connection Settings

The router supports various connection types (e.g., PPPoE, Dynamic IP, Static IP). You can adjust these settings under the 'Network' or 'Internet' section of the web management page, based on your Internet Service Provider's requirements.

6.3. Advanced Features

The MW300D may offer advanced features such as:

- **Guest Network:** Create a separate Wi-Fi network for guests to ensure your main network remains secure.
- **Parental Controls:** Manage and restrict internet access for specific devices or during certain times.
- **Firewall:** Enhance network security by configuring firewall rules.

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1. Firmware Upgrade

Regularly check for and install firmware updates from the official TP-Link/Mercusys website to ensure optimal performance and security. Firmware updates can be found in the 'System Tools' or 'Firmware Upgrade' section of the web management page.

7.2. Backup and Restore Configuration

It is recommended to back up your router's configuration settings before performing major changes or firmware upgrades. This allows you to restore your settings if needed. This option is usually found under 'System Tools' > 'Backup & Restore'.

7.3. Rebooting the Router

If you experience network issues, a simple reboot can often resolve them. You can reboot the router from the web management page ('System Tools' > 'Reboot') or by unplugging the power adapter for 10 seconds and then plugging it back in.

7.4. Cleaning

Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the router. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosols.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

8.1. No Internet Access

- Check if the DSL and Internet LEDs are solid green. If not, verify your DSL line connection and ISP settings.
- Ensure your modem (if separate) is working correctly.
- Verify your internet connection type and credentials (username/password) in the router's settings.
- Reboot the router and your modem.

8.2. Cannot Access Web Management Page

- Ensure your computer is correctly connected to a LAN port of the router.
- Verify that your computer's IP address is set to obtain automatically (DHCP).
- Try clearing your browser's cache or using a different browser.
- If you forgot the login password, you may need to reset the router to factory defaults using the Reset button.

8.3. Wireless Connection Issues

- Ensure the WLAN LED on the router is on.
- Verify you are using the correct Wi-Fi password.
- Move closer to the router to improve signal strength.
- Change the wireless channel in the router's settings to avoid interference.
