1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Bunn 44400.0100 Sure Immersion Model 220 is a commercial-grade bean-to-cup coffee brewer designed for high-volume environments. It features two independent 3 lb hoppers with precision burr grinders, air infusion extraction control for optimal flavor, and a user-friendly 10-inch color touchscreen interface. This brewer offers five customizable portion sizes and a dedicated hot water button for versatility.

2. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove the brewer from its packaging. Inspect for any shipping damage. Retain all packaging materials for future transport or service needs.

2.2 Placement

Place the brewer on a stable, level surface capable of supporting its weight. Ensure adequate clearance around the unit for ventilation and access. The brewer requires a dedicated 120V, 60Hz, 1-phase electrical supply with a 15 Amp circuit, utilizing a NEMA 5-15P plug. Ensure the electrical outlet is properly grounded.

2.3 Initial Cleaning

Before first use, wipe down all exterior surfaces with a damp cloth. Clean the bean hoppers and drip tray with mild soap and water, then rinse thoroughly and dry completely. **Note:** This appliance is not dishwasher safe.

2.4 Hopper Installation and Water Connection

1. Ensure the two 3 lb bean hoppers are clean and dry. Place them securely into their designated slots on top of the brewer.
2. Connect the brewer to a potable cold water supply using appropriate plumbing connections. It is recommended to use a water filter to prevent mineral buildup. Refer to local plumbing codes for installation requirements.

3. OPERATING THE BREWER

3.1 Powering On and Initial Start-up

Plug the brewer into the dedicated electrical outlet. The 10-inch color touchscreen will illuminate. Follow any on-screen prompts for initial setup, such as language selection or date/time settings.

3.2 Loading Coffee Beans

Open the lids of the two 3 lb hoppers. Pour fresh, whole coffee beans into each hopper. The brewer features independent grinders, allowing for different bean types in each hopper if desired.

3.3 Brewing Coffee

1. Place a suitable coffee cup or carafe under the dispense spout.
2. On the 10-inch color touchscreen, select your desired coffee type (if configured) and portion size from the five available options.
3. Press the "Brew" button on the touchscreen. The brewer will automatically grind the beans, initiate the air infusion extraction process, and dispense the coffee.
4. Wait for the brewing cycle to complete before removing the cup or carafe.

3.4 Dispensing Hot Water

To dispense hot water, place a cup under the hot water spout and press the dedicated "Hot Water" button on the touchscreen. Press the button again to stop the flow.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your Bunn Sure Immersion Model 220 brewer. Always unplug the brewer before performing any cleaning or maintenance.

4.1 Daily Cleaning

- Wipe down the exterior surfaces, including the touchscreen, with a soft, damp cloth.
- Empty and clean the drip tray.
- Remove and clean the dispense spout assembly.

4.2 Weekly Cleaning

- Clean the bean hoppers thoroughly, ensuring no residual coffee oils or grounds remain.
- Clean the grinding chambers. Refer to the on-screen menu for specific grinder cleaning cycles or instructions.

4.3 Descaling

Depending on water hardness, descaling may be required periodically to remove mineral buildup. The brewer's touchscreen may indicate when descaling is necessary. Use a commercial descaling solution specifically designed for coffee brewers and follow the manufacturer's instructions carefully. **Do not use vinegar** as it may damage internal components.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Bunn Sure Immersion Model 220 brewer. For problems not listed here, contact Bunn customer support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Brewer does not power on.	No power supply; tripped circuit breaker.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged in. Check the circuit breaker and reset if necessary.
No coffee dispenses.	No water supply; empty bean hoppers; clogged grinder/spout.	Verify water supply is connected and turned on. Refill bean hoppers. Clean the grinder and dispense spout.
Coffee tastes weak or watery.	Incorrect grind setting; insufficient coffee beans; descaling needed.	Adjust grind setting via touchscreen. Ensure hoppers have sufficient beans. Perform descaling if prompted or overdue.
Touchscreen unresponsive.	Temporary software glitch.	Unplug the brewer for 30 seconds, then plug it back in to perform a soft reset.
