INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and effective use of your Streamlight TLR-7 X Tactical Weapon Light. The TLR-7 X is a compact, high-performance weapon-mounted light designed for tactical applications, offering multi-fuel capability and versatile operation.

WARNING:

- · Always ensure the weapon is unloaded and safe before attaching or detaching the light.
- Never point the light directly into eyes, as the high lumen output can cause temporary vision impairment.
- Use only recommended battery types (CR123A or Streamlight SL-B9 lithium-ion rechargeable battery pack, sold separately).
- · Keep out of reach of children.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. Battery Installation

- 1. Ensure the light is in "Safe Off" mode to prevent accidental activation.
- 2. Unscrew the facecap of the light counter-clockwise to access the battery compartment.
- 3. Insert one (1) CR123A battery or one (1) Streamlight SL-B9 lithium-ion rechargeable battery pack (sold separately) with the positive (+) end facing towards the light head.
- 4. Screw the facecap back on clockwise until snug.

2. Mounting the Light

The TLR-7 X features an integrated rail clamp for rapid attachment and detachment.

- 1. Select the appropriate key from the included key kit for your weapon's rail type (e.g., 1913 or Universal).
- 2. Loosen the rail clamp screw on the light.
- 3. Align the light's rail clamp with your weapon's accessory rail.
- 4. Slide the light onto the rail until the key engages with a rail slot.
- 5. Tighten the rail clamp screw securely. Do not overtighten.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The TLR-7 X comes with customizable rear paddle switches (high and low) for versatile operation.

Switch Operation:

- Momentary On: Press and hold either paddle switch. Release to turn off.
- Constant On: Quickly press and release either paddle switch. Press and release again to turn off.
- **Strobe Mode:** From the "Off" position, quickly double-tap either paddle switch. To exit strobe, press and release either switch.

Safe Off Feature:

To prevent accidental activation and conserve battery life, the TLR-7 X includes a "Safe Off" feature. This is typically engaged by rotating the facecap a quarter turn counter-clockwise from the fully tightened position. To re-enable operation, rotate the facecap clockwise until fully tightened.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Wipe the light with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace batteries when the light output diminishes significantly. Always dispose of used batteries according to local regulations.
- O-Rings: Periodically inspect and lubricate the O-rings with silicone grease to maintain water resistance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Light does not turn on.	Battery depleted or incorrectly installed; "Safe Off" engaged.	Replace battery, ensure correct polarity; disengage "Safe Off" by tightening facecap.
Light output is dim.	Low battery; dirty lens.	Replace battery; clean lens with a soft cloth.
Light flickers.	Loose battery or facecap; poor contact.	Ensure battery is seated correctly and facecap is fully tightened.
